300 industrial units to start operation in Ten-Day Dawn

TEHRAN - An Industries Ministry official said that over 300 industrial units will become operational during the Ten-Day Dawn period, marking the 19th anniversary of the victory of the Islamic Revolution.

Stressing major improvement in Iran's industry sector during the post-revolution era, deputy minister for financial affairs Iraj Akbariyyeh said that majority of the country's industrial products have been manufactured by Iranian experts.

He also predicted that some Dlsr 1.3 billion worth of industrial products will be exported by March 20, 1998.

Leader praises Air Force, its drive towards self-sufficiency

TEHRAN - The Leader of the Islamic Revolution, Ayatollah Ali Khamenei, here on Sunday praised the Iranian Air Force for its honorable services to the nation, further calling on the corps to work for self-sufficiency as a necessity for total independence.

Addressing a group of visiting Air Force officers, the Leader lauded the force for its heroic pledge of allegiance to the late Imam Khomeini prior to the victory

of the 1979 Islamic Revolution, adding that the move had a significant impact on the strategy the late Imam adopted towards the army, IRNA reported.

The commander-in-chief of the armed forces stressed the enemies' displeasure with the Islamic Republic's armed forces.

Speaking of the efforts by the enemies of the nation in pre-revolution era to build an army totally dependent on foreign masters, the Leader praised the "revolutionary honor" displayed by the Islamic

Republic's army, a quality achieved through independence and broadest of efforts to attain self-sufficiency.

Producing the needed hardware and training pilots and devoted experts are amongst principal responsibilities of the Air Force, the Leader stressed,

adding "it is a source of honor to see a nation reject the foreigners and tap on its inexhaustible resources to achieve progress. This is what our nation has accomplished in various arena including the military, a prime example of which is what takes place in the Air Force."

Prior to the Leader's speech, the Air Force Commander, Brigadier General Habib Baqaei, declared the force's full readiness to carry out directives issued by the commander in chief of the armed forces.

President Khatami:

Iran favors real peace for mankind

Defense minister:

Iran will not tolerate violation of its territory

TEHRAN - Defense Minister Rear Admiral Ali Shamkhani, here on Sunday stated that the American military presence in the region lacks any political justification, adding that the U.S., despite objections by the regional countries as well U.N., is intent on taking unilateral action against Iraq.

Speaking at a press conference, Shamkhani fielded several questions from domestic and foreign reporters on the possible attack by the U.S. on Iraq and the Islamic Republic's stance on the issue, IRNA reported.

The minister foresaw the attack as "imminent and major," a testimony to which, he said, is the vehement objections to the measure by several countries including the Russians.

The U.S. seeks to divert attention from the failure of Clinton-Arafat-Netanyahu meeting to revive the Middle East compromise talks as well as the internal crisis gripping the White House itself, Shamkhani said, elaborating on the motives by the U.S. for attack on Iraq.

Shamkhani once again declared "the Islamic Republic advocates preserving the peace and stability in the

region through reliance on the regional forces themselves."

The defense minister further predicted that the U.S. would proceed with the use of nuclear weapons against Iraq, adding that the Americans had previously used the weapon in the war against Iraq which has given rise to the mysterious "Persian Gulf syndrome" amongst the American forces.

In response to a question on Iranian stance regarding American military attack on Iraq, Shamkhani said "the Iranian stance as the chairman of the Organization of the Islamic Conference is identical to the stance adopted by majority of the Muslim and regional states which oppose the move."

The Islamic Republic opposes the measure because "it's unilateral and does not enjoy international support," he added.

Responding to a question on the Islamic Republic's reaction to possible violation of its territory, Shamkhani stressed "we won't tolerate such a thing, this is something we would prove in action."

He added "Washington, fully aware of the Iranian

sensitivity regarding the defense of its territory, has so far refrained from any provocative measures in this regard."

Commenting on dangers posed by Israel and Taliban, Shamkhani stated "we won't permit any mischiefs in our borders by any groups or countries."

Noting that the recent delivery of F-15 fighter jets to Israel by the U.S. is aimed at tipping the region's military balance in favor of the Zionist regime, Shamkhani stressed that Israel, if convinced of its ability, would not miss any opportunity to harm the interests of the Muslim world. However, he added, the regime presently does not see itself to have the upper hand.

The Iranian defense minister spoke of efforts to bring about military cooperation amongst regional countries including holding of a joint military maneuver, further predicting that the efforts would bear fruit in the near future.

Responding to a question regarding the alleged Chinese change of mind in supplying Iran with certain military hardware, Shamkhani said "the Chinese weapon deal pointed to by the Western press, involves some weaponry which the Islamic Republic is itself capable of producing."

On the issue of the three Iranian islands in the Persian Gulf, Shamkhani said that some foreign countries are using the issue to justify their (military) presence in the region.

"Iran is fully prepared to reach an understanding with the UAE within the framework of the 1971 agreement," he said further predicting that such an understanding would be reached in the future.

Commenting on the state of the Iranian army, Shamkhani stated that the pre-revolution army served the U.S. interests, while the post-revolution army, under the leadership of a spiritual leader and relying on the domestic and inherent abilities, is at the service of the Iranian nation, Shamkhani concluded.

He hoped that his negotiations with Iranian officials in Tehran would serve to boost bilateral relations in cultural, scientific, arts and

Jordanian ambassador:

Iran assumes outstanding role in world of Islam

TEHRAN - Jordanian Ambassador to Tehran Noh Ali Salman in a meeting here Sunday submitted to First Vice-President Hassan Habibi the message of Jordanian Crown Prince Hassan ibn Talal for President Mohammad Khatami.

Habibi said that many problems facing the world of Islam would be solved if Muslim states stood firm to U.S. threats and convinced that country that it was not the U.S. that decides on behalf of the world's peoples, IRNA reported.

He said that cooperation of Muslim states with the chairman of the Organization of Islamic Conference (OIC) on international scene is "important" and would ensure the organization's success in various scenes.

He added that good and constructive approach of the participants in the 8th OIC summit, held in Tehran from December 9-11, 1997, heartened the Muslim world. He wished that the OIC heads of state would attain further success in their international relations in light of their cooperation and unanimity of views.

He expressed regret over the crisis gripping Iraq and called for cooperation among Muslim states to solve the crisis.

He thanked Salman for the message and said that Tehran and Amman enjoy good relations.

Thanking Iran for hosting the OIC summit successfully, Salman said that relations between Iran and Jordan are developing.

As a country leading Muslim states, said Salman, Iran assumes an outstanding role in the world of Islam at present and can solve many problems faced by Muslim states.

Iran urges Algeria to announce clear stand toward massacres

TEHRAN - Iranian Foreign Ministry spokesman Mahmoud Mohammadi on Sunday urged the Algerian government to announce a clear stand toward massacre of the innocent people in that country.

The Algerian government has reacted negatively to Iran's expression of sympathy with the victims of the tragic events in Algeria.

TEHRAN - Colombian Minister of Culture Ramiro Osorio Funks on Sunday handed over a message from President Ernesto Samper Pizano to President Mohammad Khatami.

President Khatami said in the 20th century the countries still talked to each other by means of force and politics, hoping that in the next century, the nations would communicate with one another by means of culture, IRNA reported.

He said, "unfortunately, politics have dominated religion and culture, but, if politics and military force are brought under control of the culture, the destiny of human beings will change."

The politically-dominated world speaks of confrontation among the civilizations whereas the culture advocates building understanding through dialog, President Khatami said.

He said, "we hope to enter into a process (in 21st century) that dialog between the civilizations and understanding among the nations will prevail instead of the current confrontation among the civilizations."

Khatami said Colombia as the chairman of the Non-Aligned Movement (NAM) and the Islamic Republic of Iran as the chairman of the Organization of the Islamic Conference (OIC) would cooperate to assume a decisive role on the international scene.

He said the Islamic Republic of Iran is interested in real peace for all mankind, especially for the nations in the South.

Osorio said Tehran-Bogota relations are excellent adding that Colombia is willing to develop cooperation with the Islamic Republic of Iran.

He hoped that his negotiations with Iranian officials in Tehran would serve to boost bilateral relations in cultural, scientific, arts and

Chairman of Oman Chamber of Commerce Sheikh bin Halal al-Khalili said at the meeting that Oman is keen on widening scope of bilateral commercial transactions to cover commercial, industrial, tourism and banking fields, IRNA reported.

Al-Khalili said that Oman would support any move taken to strengthen cooperation among Muslim states.

He welcomed formation of a common Muslim market

and said that Iran and Oman can cooperate with each other in the areas of fisheries and tourism under joint venture projects.

Oman is also interested to make use of Iran's facilities and experiences in the field of afforestation.

Head of the Iranian

Khamoushi said that Iranian free trade zones (FTZ's) have the capacity of absorbing foreign investment and serving as a venue for joint venture projects. Oman can make use of Iranian free trade zones' facilities, IRNA reported.

He hoped that the two sides would endorse draft of an agreement for encouragement and support of mutual investments at the sixth Tehran-Muscat joint commission session.

Khamoushi called on Iranian and Omani private sectors to set up pharmaceutical plants and proposed setting up joint industrial and fishing units. He said Iran welcomes establishment of two hotels in the holy city of Mashhad (Khorasan Province) by Omani entrepreneurs.

Iranian made tugboat launched

AHVAZ, Khuzestan - Minister of Roads and Transport Mahmoud Hojati attended a ceremony marking the launch of an Iranian made tugboat 'Rashid-3' at Imam Khomeini Port.

The Iranian tugboat has a 4,400 horse power engine enabling it to immediately give services to the ships anchored near harbor.

Rashid-3 with a speed of 14 nautical mile is 33.8 meters long, 8.45 meters wide and 4.73 meters high.

The tugboat has been constructed at a total cost of Rls 1.18 billion.

Judiciary head:

German trial consistent with Iran's legal procedures

TEHRAN - The head of the judiciary, Ayatollah Mohammad Yazdi, here on Sunday stressed that the trial of the German businessman Helmut Hofer has been carried out according to the legal procedures of the Islamic Republic of Iran.

Speaking at the meeting of judiciary's executive authorities, Yazdi added "the trial of the German businessman has been conducted in presence of an attorney and an appeal has also been

filed," IRNA reported.

Shifting to another issue, the judiciary chief stressed the importance of periodic inspection of the country's prisons, adding that the judicial office for women affairs has recently compiled regulations on women prisons. The regulations would go into effect upon approval, he added.

Helmut Hofer was tried on charges of having sex out of wedlock with a Muslim woman and awaits a final verdict.

Cuba keen on expanding trade, oil cooperation with Iran

TEHRAN - The visiting Cuban Minister of Foreign Trade, Ricardo Cabrisas Ruiz, who is heading a high ranking economic delegation to Iran, met here on Sunday with Iran's Minister of Foreign Affairs Kamal Kharrazi.

The Cuban minister said the aim of his visit to Iran was to develop and expand mutual cooperation in various fields, IRNA reported.

He said Iran and Cuba have reached many agreements on economic cooperation, adding that Cuba is interested in further expanding its relations with Iran.

He also appreciated the permanent support shown by the people and the government of Islamic Republic of Iran for the Cuban government and people.

The Cuban minister handed over Kharrazi the written message of Cuban foreign minister, inviting him to pay an official visit to Havana.

The Iranian foreign minister on his part said that expansion of all-out cooperation with Cuba is among policies of the Islamic Republic of Iran.

Referring to the positive trend of economic cooperation between the two countries, Kharrazi expressed hope that Iran-Cuba joint economic commission would be formed as soon as possible to explore new avenues for mutual cooperation.

Later on Sunday, the visiting Cuban minister of foreign trade met and conferred with Iran's Minister of Oil Bijan Namdar Zanganeh, according to the public relation office of the Oil Ministry.

In the meeting, the two sides exchanged views on issues of mutual interest and expressed pleasure with the expanding cooperation between the two countries.

Other topics discussed by the two sides included transfer of technological know-how, conduct of joint research, exchange of experiences and information as well as the likelihood of making sugar for oil deal.

Meanwhile, the Cuban minister held talks here on Sunday with Iran's Deputy Minister of Commerce Hussein Noghrehkar-Shirazi on bilateral trade relations and matters of mutual interest.

The Cuban minister expressed his country's readiness for sugar for oil deal with Iran, inauguration of Cuban trade information center in the country and supporting Iran's membership in the International Sugar Trade Organization.

Cabrisas Ruiz said that it is very important for Cuba to supply its needed crude oil from the Islamic Republic of Iran because Iran has always supported Cuba against the economic sanction imposed by the United States of America.

He added that the Cuban delegation is to hold talks with Iranian officials on repayment of Cuba's debts to Iran and the banks from two sides have already reached agreements in this regard.

He also expressed hope that during his stay here he would be able to take some positive steps in further expansion of economic ties between the two countries.

The Iranian deputy minister on his part expressed hope that the upcoming visit of Iranian First Vice-President Hassan Habibi to Havana would leave effective impacts on consolidation of mutual economic ties between Tehran and Havana.

He further added that the joint economic commission would meet soon to further expand economic cooperation and remove current hurdles on the way.

Noghrehkar-Shirazi called for bilateral cooperation in such areas as setting up trade fairs in either country as well as talks between the Iranian and Cuban chambers of commerce.

Interior minister:

Scientific, cultural centers play highly sensitive role
