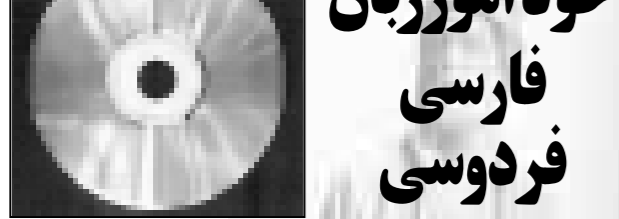

New gas field discovered in Fars Province

TEHRAN - Deputy Oil Minister Ali Hashemi said a new gas-field has been discovered at Gordan, Fars Province with 2.1 trillion cubic feet gas reserve and 10.5 million barrels of liquid gas.

Hashemi said the new gas field is worth Dlr. three billion and its liquid gas Dlr. 200 million.

He said that Gordan gas-field is located in Taghdis, 135 km south of Shiraz.

He said the Oil Ministry has planned to develop the gas-field within the next two years.

Khatami:

Islamic culture, most important pillar of Iranian identity

ZAHEDAN, Sistan-Baluchestan - Iran's President Mohammad Khatami, here on Tuesday referred to the 1979 Islamic Revolution as the initiator of a new move towards a new life within a new system.

Speaking to an audience of Sunni and Shi'ite clerics as well as prominent personalities of the province, Khatami stated "Islamic culture constitutes the most important pillar of our cultural identity," adding that Islam has played the greatest of roles in the exaltation of the Iranian nation, IRNA reported.

Touching on the subject of Shi'ite-Sunni unity in the country, the president said that it's only in a developed Iran that both Muslim sects can thrive.

The chief executive spoke of efforts during the past 200 years to use religion and ethnicity as instruments to divide the nation, adding that the efforts gave rise to a mentality which is detrimental to the solidarity amongst people.

He called on religious and cultural leaders to try to remove these negative mentalities as a step towards consolidating unity within the community.

Turning to the special needs of the south eastern

province, Khatami said that the existence of a 30,000-strong college student population stresses the need to raise the standards of education in the provincial universities.

The chief executive also stated that measures are needed to create a suitable environment for advancement of women in the province which he said has been traditionally sluggish.

Meanwhile, addressing a gathering of families of martyrs and war veterans after his arrival at Zahedan, president Khatami said that the country owes its dignity, independence and security to the martyrs and war veterans.

He further added that the nation can pay its dues to those who sacrificed their lives for the nation by building a country where women and men with various ethnicities live with dignity and security.

President Khatami arrived in Sistan-Baluchestan Tuesday morning to inaugurate several development projects.

Iran's Sistan-Baluchestan has a Sunni majority while the Shi'ites are the overall majority in the country.

The president also told a large gathering of local people later on Tuesday that

his administration has placed a priority on fighting drug abuse and trafficking in this province.

The Iranian president who was addressing his audience at the 17-Shahrivar sports stadium said the enemies of the Islamic Republic have tried to take advantage of the presence in Sistan-Baluchestan Province of various groupings of the Islamic faith and done everything to pit one group against the other. He said all persons able to influence the people in the province and persuade them towards their solidarity must make sure that the people in the province will remain a united whole as they are in every other province of Iran.

President Khatami also deplored the province being less developed than other provinces of Iran. He said about Rls. 32 billion had been allocated for a water supply project in the province this year. He said another Rls. 40 billion had also been allocated to the project from presidential credits.

He said about Rls. 160 billion would be invested in the province for improving main roads and the airport of the city this year.

President Khatami said the province is an important gate of Iran to other parts of

the world and has therefore a special geographical prominence.

On Tuesday afternoon, President Khatami also saw over the site of a project for conducting potable water from Zabol in the province to Zahedan.

Energy Minister of Iran Habibollah Bitaraf who is with President Khatami in his tour of the province said Tuesday that the water supply project in the province is one of the most important projects of its kind in Iran.

Later on Tuesday, President Khatami visited an exhibit of industrial development in this southeastern province named "the face of Sistan-Baluchestan Province."

The exhibit consisted of 50 booths and showcased industrial accomplishments of various public and private organizations in the province.

Highlighting the existence of rich artistic talents in the province, President Khatami expressed hope that handicrafts can help the province gain a respectable share of the country's exports.

3,000-year-old cemetery unearthed in northern Iran

RASHT, Gilan - An ancient cemetery was unearthed in Eshkevar village of Roudsar town in northern Iran during operations to instal electricity pylons last week.

Director of Gilan Province Cultural Heritage Department Mohammad Taqi Kazazi said that preliminary studies show that the cemetery dates back to the first millennium B.C. and belongs to the Achaemenid era.

Some clay pots and objects have been discovered next to human skeletons, he further added. The official said that expert studies and research works will continue in the region to find out more about its historical significance.

Japanese delegation arrives:

Japan determined to expand relations with Iran

TEHRAN - Japanese Deputy Foreign Minister Masahiko Komura, heading a delegation, arrived here Wednesday on a four-day official visit.

Komura, the second top official at Japan's Foreign Ministry, is the highest-ranking Japanese official to visit Iran since the former foreign minister Taro Nakaya visited the country seven years ago.

During his stay, Komura will submit a message from Japanese Prime Minister Ryutaro Hashimoto to President Mohammad Khatami.

Prior to his departure, he told IRNA in Tokyo that due to realistic policies of the new Iranian administration, his country is determined to expand its relations with the Islamic Republic in all fields.

Iran-Pakistan cooperation a must to bring peace to Afghanistan

TEHRAN - Pakistan's special envoy on Afghan affairs, Iftekhar Murshid, here on Tuesday stated "cooperation between Iran and Pakistan is an absolute necessity to bring the Afghan peace process to a successful conclusion."

In a meeting with his Iranian counterpart, Alaeddin Boroujerdi, Murshid added "the Pakistani government and the prime minister himself are determined to bring the Afghan crisis to an end, a feat we are hoping to achieve through cooperation with the Islamic Republic of Iran," IRNA reported.

He further referred to the Taliban's announced readiness to enter into negotiations with their opposition as a step towards creating understanding amongst the Afghan warring factions.

The Pakistani official further briefed Boroujerdi on the results of the visit of the American delegation to Pakistan and Afghanistan as well as the negotiations involving the representatives of U.N. and the Organization of the Islamic Conference (OIC) regarding the Afghan crisis.

Boroujerdi welcomed the Pakistani proposal to coop-

erate with Iran to bring the Afghan war to an end, adding that Iran supports cooperation between U.N. and the OIC to resolve the Afghan crisis.

The two officials also stressed the importance of Iran-Pakistan cooperation to combat narcotics trafficking.

Iftekhar Murshid arrived in Tehran on Tuesday to confer with Iranian officials over the latest developments in Afghanistan.

Later on Tuesday, the Pakistani envoy briefed Iran's Foreign Minister Kamal Kharrazi on a visit to Islamabad by a U.S. delegation earlier this month.

He said his government advocates peaceful solution of the situation in neighboring Afghanistan and also recalled the capacity of Iran and Pakistan to return peace to that

country. In their meetings here, the Pakistani official and Iran's foreign minister also discussed the possible contribution of the United Nations to that goal as well as the role of the Organization of the Islamic Conference (OIC), and Iran-Pakistan relations.

The Iranian foreign minister observed that civil war and fratricide must be brought to an end in Afghanistan. He also said that foreign intervention in the internal affairs of that country should be prevented, and practical measures must be adopted for returning peace to that country.

Kharrazi also observed that security and stability in Afghanistan would have direct impact on the national security of Iran and Pakistan.

Foreign Ministry criticizes U.S. old-time policy toward Iran

TEHRAN - Iranian Foreign Ministry spokesman Mahmoud Mohammadi on Tuesday criticized the U.S. old-time policy, accusing Washington of ignoring the facts in the world community, the regional situation and the realities in modern Iran.

He said Washington's long-standing accusation against Iran of supporting terrorism is the continuation of the U.S. policy of threat and imposing economic sanctions on the other countries especially the Islamic Republic of Iran, IRNA reported.

"Despite the developments in the international community, the U.S. looks at Iran with a mentality belonging to the Cold War era.

Washington has turned a blind eye to the modern day realities, the Foreign Ministry spokesman said.

Mohammadi said the Islamic Republic of Iran is against extortion, violence and terrorism in the international relations.

He said, "the U.S. should show reaction to Israeli-sponsored state terrorism far from contradiction in word and deed."

Iran believes that the U.S. double standard is based on the wrong mentality of the U.S. administration towards the Iranian nation and that it is the U.S. that should correct its policies towards Iran.

Expansion of ties with Arab, Muslim states high on Iran's agenda

TEHRAN, - The Minister of Culture and Islamic Guidance, Ataollah Mohajerani, said that expansion of relations with Arab and Islamic states is amongst the highest priorities of the Islamic Republic of Iran.

In a meeting with the Moroccan Ambassador to Tehran, Mohammad Ezerwal, Mohajerani stressed Iran's desire to expand its ties with Morocco, adding that tourism, archeology and movie industry are potential areas of cooperation between the two

countries, IRNA reported.

He further referred to the conference of Islamic states' ministers of culture in Morocco in August as a suitable venue to explore ways of expanding cultural ties amongst the states.

As a measure to expand cultural exchanges between Iranian writers and their Arab counterparts, Mohajerani referred to his ministry's effort to make Arab states' newspapers available in Iran.

The Moroccan am-

bassador expressed his government's resolve to expand its relations with the Islamic Republic of Iran.

The exchange of political and cultural delegations have played a key role in expansion of ties between Iran and Morocco in the recent years, the ambassador added.

Ziaie-Far:

U.N. Human Rights Commission report unauthentic

TEHRAN - Secretary of Islamic Human Rights Commission commenting on the report of the U.N. Human Rights Commission (UNHRC) on Iran, said that Maurice Danby Capithorne has been dishonest in his report to the General Assembly.

In an interview with 'Tehran Times' published Tuesday, Hassan Ziaie-Far added that the report presented to the UNHRC was softer than the one presented to the General Assembly, while the General Assembly is more important than the UNHRC.

The U.N. rapporteur has not based his report on reliable sources, he criticized and added that Capithorne himself has admitted in his report that his sources are mainly the groups which are terrorist by nature and are opponents of the Islamic system.

It is but natural that such groups provide him with false reports.

Ironically, some of these groups have been declared as terrorist groups, even by some Western countries, he added.

Therefore reports based on the information provided by such groups is unauthentic, he stated.

The U.N. rapporteur has failed to have a comprehensive look at the Iranian society as a religious one, he said.

"Assessing Iran's performance of human rights on the basis of secular criteria not only will not solve any problem, but will add to the complexity of the problem," he said.

Moreover, the U.N. rapporteur has neglected the positive developments with regard to human rights in Iran and has concentrated on weak points.

For instance, the developments of the past six months and the opening up of the society as well as the role of the press have been neglected by Capithorne, he added.

Based on the latest statistics, some 1,000 publications have received permits during the past 12 months. There is no control over these publications before they are published.

He said last year a minister filed a suit against a publication, but the court ruling was in favor of the publication.

"In last year's film festival a number of actresses won prizes, but outside Iran the propaganda campaign is too distorted that people think that the Iranian women even do not go to cinema. None of these positive aspects are seen in Capithorne's report," he concluded.

The gathering ended peacefully after two hours of discussions.

While entering the parking lot of the university, the MPs were prevented by a guard from parking their car without having a special permit.

Later an argument erupted between them and when a university instructor intervened to calm down the situation, the MPs pushed him backward, leading to trade of insults.

The students asked the MPs to apologize to the university instructor, staffers and students for their unacceptable behavior.

The gathering ended peacefully after two hours of discussions.

Armenian official:

Iran can preserve regional peace, stability

TEHRAN - An Armenian official said on Tuesday that his country attaches great importance to ties with Iran, adding that the Islamic Republic can preserve peace and stability in the region.

Head of the Iranology center of Armenia Garnik Asatryan told visiting Iranian Deputy Foreign Minister for Euro-African Affairs Morteza Sarmadi that Armenia highly values its cooperation with Iran, based on mutual interests, IRNA reported from Moscow.

He said the center is to organize an international congress of Iranologists worldwide in 1999.

Sarmadi underlined importance of Iranology studies in the Caucasus, adding that the next century will be the era of dialog among civilizations and exchange of views among different cultures.

Therefore, he stressed, the role that Caucasian intellectuals can play in the region is very crucial and significant in forging solidarity and consolidating ties among regional nations.

Sarmadi stated that in the new era the Islamic Republic of Iran centers its policy on the principle of easing tension and establishing closer ties with its neighbors.

Wheat production to reach 11m tons this year

TEHRAN - According to estimates by the Agriculture Ministry the domestic production of wheat will reach 10.5 to 11 million tons this year (started March, 21), seven million tons of which will be purchased from farmers as their surplus products, said the deputy head of Grain Organization Masoud Kouchak-Mohseni here Tuesday.

Attending a three day seminar of directors of Grain Organization, he told IRNA that in order to supply bread for the Iranian population, three million tons of wheat will be imported this year.

This year, Kouchak-

Mohseni said, wheat will be purchased from farmers at a price of Rls. 600 per kilograms, and if additional expenses are added to this figure, the cost price of wheat will be Rls. 720 per kilograms.

He added that, currently the capacity of Iranian silos for storage of wheat is 4.5 million tons which is still inadequate despite investments so far made in building new silos and warehouses.

He added that the Agriculture Ministry envisions a program to build enough silos for storage of 1.2 million tons of wheat.

Kouchak-Mohseni said

that before the victory of Islamic Revolution, silos used to be built by foreigners but now they are constructed and their equipment installed by Iranian experts.

He further added until a few years ago building a 50,000 ton silo cost Dlr. two to 2.5 million whereas, today with the improvement in technology, this figure has reduced to Rls. four billion.

Omani speaker calls for promotion of parliamentary ties with Iran

TEHRAN - Speaker of Omani Consultative Council Abdullah bin Ali al-Qatabi, and Iran's Ambassador to Oman Syavash Zargar Yaqoubi in Muscat reviewed the latest developments in the two countries relations.

Further promotion of Tehran-Muscat parliamentary cooperation was also among topics discussed by the two officials.

Referring to the future visit of Majlis Speaker Ali Akbar Nateq Nouri to Oman, slated

for April 25-27, al-Qatabi expressed the hope that the visit will further promote parliamentary relations between the two countries.

He voiced readiness of Omani parliament to cooperate with the Iranian Majlis.

Service sector absorbs highest number of manpower in Iran

TEHRAN - Some 44.5 percent of Iran's work force was employed at services sector in the Iranian year 1375 (ended March 20, 1997).

Iran's Statistics Center, in a report said that 30.7 percent of the active population of the country is engaged at industrial sector and 23 at agricultural sector.

According to the 1375 public census, the number of those active in industrial and services sectors rose by 5.4 percent and 2.1 percent respectively, compared to the year 1365 (1986-1987).

On the contrary, the number of people active in agricultural sector dropped by about six percent.

The report indicated that women's employment climbed by 11.6 percent and men's by 4.7 percent in industrial sector over the same period.

In agricultural sector, the employment rate declined by 9.9 percent for women and 6.7 percent for men.

Men comprised 87.9 percent and women 12.1 percent of the total active population of over 10 years of age in the

country in 1375.

This demonstrates a 3.2 percent fall in men's employment and an increase of 3.2 percent for women.

According to the statistics center, 14,571,572 persons were working countrywide in the year 1375, registering an increase of 3,570,021 persons compared to the year 1365.
