

## Iran expresses concern over Ethiopia-Eritrea conflicts

TEHRAN - The Iranian Foreign Ministry Sunday voiced concern over recent confrontations between Ethiopia and Eritrea.

Spokesman of the Iranian Foreign Ministry Mahmoud Mohammadi said the Islamic Republic would support every sincere effort for ending the conflict between the two nations and returning peace to the African region, IRNA reported.

He hoped both countries would respect each other's territorial integrity and exercise self-restraint so that the present alarming situation in that part of the world would end peacefully.

### Rowhani:

## Iran, Turkey relations play key role in regional peace

TEHRAN - Majlis Vice-Speaker Hassan Rowhani said here Sunday that Iran and Turkey are the two great Islamic countries in the region whose bilateral relations play a key role in establishment of peace and stability in the entire region.

In a meeting with Turkish Ambassador to Tehran Sencer Ozsoy, Rowhani, who is also chairman of Majlis Foreign Policy Commission expressed concern over Turkish military activities in northern Iraq and Ankara-Tel Aviv military cooperation, IRNA reported.

He said that the two countries were active in the Organization of the Islamic Conference (OIC) and the contact group during the critical situation in Bosnia-Herzegovina.

He expressed hope that the two countries' cooperation will also help settle the crisis in Kosovo.

Underlining the need to further activate the two countries joint economic and security commissions, Rowhani called for promotion of Tehran-Ankara economic relations.

The vice-speaker called for cooperation between the two countries parliaments in all fields, and between specialized commissions and parliamentary friendship groups in particular.

Referring to Iran and Turkey as two friendly countries, the Turkish ambassador called for expansion of bilateral ties.

He assured that Ankara-Tel Aviv cooperation will not be against the interests of any regional country including the Islamic Republic of Iran. Ozsoy concluded by voicing his country's readiness to help settle the Kosovo crisis.

### Mohajerani:

## Iranian press display considerable growth

TEHRAN - Minister of Culture and Islamic Guidance Ataollah Mohajerani, said that the Iranian press have registered a considerable growth since the May 23 presidential elections.

He told the managers and editorial board of Iran Cultural and Press Institute that the press today are diverse in terms of their outlooks because "our people, too, are diverse in terms of their outlooks and have different demands," IRNA reported.

"Our main task is to find a common point for these divergent opinions," said the minister adding the Iran Institute has taken positive steps in this respect.

Mohajerani said there are signs here and there that some hands are at work to insinuate that President Mohammad Khatami an his administration are not sensitive towards religious identity, principles of revolution and Islamic values.

He added that this attitude which is being raised in the society repeatedly is a cruelty perpetrated against the president and his government.

"Given the exalted thoughts and characteristics enjoyed by the president, how can one raise such charges against him," asked the minister.

### Kamali:

## Islamic nations must boost technical cooperation

TEHRAN - Minister of Labor and Social Affairs Hussein Kamali said here Sunday that exchange of technical know-how and economic cooperation among Islamic countries will reduce their dependence on Western countries. Kamali told the Yemeni Ambassador to Tehran, Abdullah Ali al-Razi, that expansion of technical cooperation and increase in trade exchanges not only will help Muslim states to meet their needs but will turn them into an economic power at international level, IRNA reported.

Describing Tehran-San'a ties as favorable, he said given common cultural bonds, the two countries should boost their technical and economic cooperation.

He called for implementation of the letter of understanding signed by the two countries during the visit to Tehran of the Yemeni Labor Minister, Muhammad Muhammad al-Tayyib, in March.

The ambassador handed over Al-Tayyib's letter of invitation to Kamali for a visit to Yemen.

## Iran plans to export tyre this year

TEHRAN - Production of tyre in Iran reached 150,000 tons last year, while the figure is expected to increase to 190,000 tons this year, three times as many as the figure at the onset of the First Five-Year Development Plan, said Mahmoud Edalatian, director general of the chemical and cellulose department of the Industries Ministry Mahmoud Edalatian.

He said that lack of proper policies for import of tyre last year caused domestic factories not to be able to run at their nominal capacity of 180,000 tons combined.

He called on the Central Bank of Iran to provide tyre manufacturing units with necessary credits for production of tyre.

Edalatian said that his ministry plans to export between 15 and 20 percent of the country's tyre output, worth Dir 30 million, this year.

He said the country will be self-sufficient in tyre production if several related projects are put into operation by the year end on March 20, 1999.

Edalatian said the country's eighth light and heavy tyre manufacturing units, with a total capacity of 25,500 tons of tyre, is to be put into operation in the northeastern province of Khorasan.

Furthermore, operations are underway to set up a 25,000-ton tyre manufacturing plant in Chaharmahal-Bakhtiari Province and a 13,000-ton factory in

Khuzestan Province, added Edalatian.

He expressed hope that the country's tyre output will exceed 290,000 tons by the end of the Second Five-Year Development plan (1995-1999), of which 230,000 tons will be consumed domestically and rest exported.

Elsewhere in his remarks, Edalatian said paper and cardboard production has increased to about 500,000 tons this year from 240,000 tons in 1994 and 80,000 tons in the years 1978 and 1979.

Putting domestic demand for paper at 700,000 tons at present, Edalatian expressed hope that paper production would exceed 750,000 tons yearly following commissioning of five paper mills in western parts of the country,

## Saudi trade delegation to visit Tehran

TEHRAN - A commercial delegation from Saudi Arabia, led by head of commerce chambers of Islamic countries and Jeddah, is to arrive in Tehran on Tuesday.

The visit is aimed at upgrading Iran-Saudi relations as well as making arrangements for streamlining trade affairs among Islamic countries.

Head of the delegation Ismail Abudavoud is scheduled to have talks with some Iranian economic officials and visit a number of industrial centers during his stay in Iran, IRNA reported.

Economic sources in Saudi Arabia predicted that the visit by Abudavoud, who is among ranking economic officials of Saudi Arabia, would help strengthen bilateral economic and commercial bonds and those among other Muslim countries.

## Presence of Indian navy not for joint military maneuver

TEHRAN - An informed source at the Foreign Ministry said on Sunday that the presence of Indian navy ships in the Persian Gulf is merely part of pre-planned visits to some countries of the Persian Gulf including Iran, and not for joint military exercises.

The visit is taking place in the framework of a series of friendly visits by Indian vessels which included not only Iran, but also Saudi Arabia, Oman and Kuwait, the Foreign Ministry official said. The official said the coincidence of arrival of the Indian vessels with the nuclear tests by India and Pakistan in May is accidental.

"Holding naval exercise with participation of several states requires programming at least months ahead," the official said in reaction to a report in Indian dailies alleging that Iran and India would hold joint naval exercise in the Persian Gulf from June 9.

## Youth seeking a new phenomenon

TEHRAN - A Majlis deputy said that although sixty percent of the population consists of the youth, at present no guild or non-guild formation exists for them.

Mohammad Reza Milani Hussein, Tabriz deputy, told Iran News that in the past twenty years the revolution has put behind very turbulent times which has fallen on the shoulders of the youth.

Participation of the youth in the last presidential election proved that they are seeking a new phenomenon. It also demonstrates that they are working hard.

"Their presence at the polling booths showed that the people sense a knot in

the problem of the youth, and if we can solve this problem, economic problems will be solved too," he continued.

Regarding factionalism Hussein said, "our political factions have changed their essence, they are not what they used to be."

He said in countries undergoing a revolution, in the first stages a special viewpoint is necessary for the stabilization of the revolution, called a revolutionary stance which is totally justified.

"In order to establish the values of the revolution, another viewpoint must take shape, called the political viewpoint," Hussein told the

## Permits for import, storage of goods at Sirjan free of charge

KERMAN - Permits for the import and storage of goods and raw materials to Sirjan economic zone (SEZ) will be issued free of charge, said Director General of Sirjan SEZ Mo-

hammad Shahbakhsh.

He told IRNA that businessmen and owners of industries can store their import goods, either for export or on transit, for any period of time in roofed or open

storage areas of the zone.

Shahbakhsh said that storage charges and insurance expenses are in local currency, rial, while railway transportation of goods from Sirjan to Bandar-Abbas and vice versa is half the regular price.

Moreover, storage expenses dropped by 25 percent in the current Iranian year (started March, 21) compared to the previous year, he added.

The director general further said that international transportation companies which are cooperating with Kerman Development Organization are prepared to transport goods from various destinations around the world directly to Sirjan.

Shahbakhsh concluded by saying that more than 100,000 square meters of roofed area and over 400,000 square meters of open storage space is ready to be used at Sirjan SEZ.

Putting the value of goods exported by the aforesaid units at Dir 318 million, he expressed hope that the figure would reach Dir 400 million this year.

## Pakistan, Sierra Leone review health cooperation with Iran

TEHRAN - The ambassadors of Pakistan and Sierra Leone to Iran held separate talks with Iranian Health Minister Mohammad Farhadi on bilateral health cooperation.

Javid Hussein of Pakistan voiced his country's interest in developing health cooperation with the Islamic Republic of Iran.

In a separate meeting with Sierra Leonean Ambassador to Iran Ms. Hajieh Alari Kool, Farhadi said Iran is willing to send medicine and scientific delegations to Sierra Leone and admit medical students from that country.

## Tehran mayor terms all charges as "baseless"

TEHRAN - Tehran Mayor Gholamhussein Karbaschi at the opening session of his trial Sunday rejected all charges levelled against him terming them as "baseless".

The session which was held at branch 26 of special court chaired by Mohseni Ejei, declared Karbaschi's charges as embezzlement of Rls. 14.53 billion plus Dir. 90,000 as well as 60 full size gold coins, 80 half size gold coins, receiving bribes, mismanagement of public funds, illegitimate ownership of public properties and fraud, IRNA reported.

Karbaschi is also charged with granting Rls. 250 million to two former district mayors, Taq-vamaneh and Tajeran, to fund their election campaigns at the fifth Majlis. Both candidates failed to secure votes to become Majlis deputies.

The Tehran mayor is also to respond to charges for purchasing a building worth Rls. 3,800 million for 'Aftabgardan' Institute and misappropriation of public properties.

Continuing with the charges, Mohseni read out some memoranda from the Interior Ministry calling on the mayor to curb building of towers and not to allow conversion of wooded areas to building sites.

He further enumerated "earning revenues through formation of compromise commissions" and "lack of proper management in the municipality which departing from laws, embarked on formation of other firms" as other charges against Karbaschi.

In his statements, Ejei referred to Karbaschi as "the suspended mayor of Tehran."

Karbaschi started his defense with "I reject all the charges levelled against me as mere lies."

He also rejected the competence of the present as well as the previous

court, adding that the previous judge, Nomeiri, had prejudged the mayor as "corrupt" and thus was doing his best to bring a guilty verdict against him.

He further rejected the competence of Nomeiri on the grounds that he lacked a diploma in the judicial field.

Mohseni disrupted Karbaschi statements, and rejected his allegation that there was any prejudice against the suspended mayor.

But Karbaschi insisted on the point, adding "the case from the very beginning was shaped assuming a guilty verdict, and you being the judge as well as the head of the special judicial complex is against the law."

When asked by Ejei to elaborate on his charge, Karbaschi referred to a ban on people holding two government jobs.

Turning to the treatment he received during his 11-day detention, Karbaschi said that he was treated well in sharp contrast with other municipality officials which he said had been mistreated in jail.

"All the confessions in the case are obtained under pressure," he added.

Karbaschi also protested the judge's decision during his detention not to allow any visits by his lawyer.

One of Karbaschi's lawyers, Massood Ha'eri, protested to the judge for disrupting Karbaschi's statements.

He further repeated his clients charge that by holding various conflicting jobs, Mohseni Ejei is not qualified to preside over the case.

The judge then raised the issue of a cash contribution he said was made by the municipality to the election campaigns of two of the candidates for the fifth Majlis.

Karbaschi responded by saying that the account the contributions were withdrawn from, was not that of the municipality but was rather the personal account

of some senior officials of the municipality.

He further elaborated by saying "the account, per authorization by the City Council, is used to disperse bonuses to the managers at the year end."

Reiterating that the account was personal, Karbaschi said that details such as when and how the funds in the account were dispersed did not concern the municipality from legal point of view.

However, he added, per authorization from the interior minister, the mayor was in position to make decisions about the disbursement of the fund in form of grants or loans.

Mohseni rejected the suspended mayor's explanation, adding "the said account was not a personal account."

When pressed to acknowledge the payment of some Rls. 250 million to the then Majlis candidates, Taqva-Manesh and Tajeran, Karbaschi, said "yes, the said people were municipality managers, and it was normal for us to give loans or grants to our managers."

"Rls. 200 million of the said payment was in form of loans and the balance was in form of grants which was later paid back."

Karbaschi acknowledged that there were no documents associated with the alleged loans.

Responding to the judge's statement that the recipients of the funds had said that the fund under dispute was no loan and they had no intention of repaying it, Karbaschi said "we were not obliged to collect the money, just as on one occasion we covered the medical bills of our managers amounting to Rls. 200 million."

"Did you have the authorization to use the account any way you deemed necessary?" the judge asked. Affirmative, Karbaschi responded.

Mohseni then raised the issue of some Rls. 2.6 billion contributed to the Majlis election campaigns of candidates fielded by 'Kargozaran' (sevents of construction), which constitute another charge against Karbaschi.

Karbaschi said that the contribution was in form of a loan which he said was paid off including interest within a 15 month period.

Kargozaran, formed by some senior executives of the former President Akbar Hashemi Rafsanjani's administration, supported the candidacy of Mohammad Khatami in last year's presidential election.

Karbaschi however acknowledged that there were no documents associated with the payments. He further charged that the court is raising the issue to politicize the case.

The next charge raised by the judge, was the issue of a Rls. 200 million deposit in the suspended mayor's account which Mohseni said was made from a joint account belonging to Orumiyeh municipality.

Karbaschi said that the interest free loan was actually made by the Interior Ministry to him. The term of the loan was extended to four years which has not expired yet, he added.

The purchase of a building by the municipality, which was eventually transferred to the 'Aftabgardan' Cultural Institution was next raised by the judge.

Karbaschi explained that the municipality purchased the building for Rls. 3,320 million and then charged the cultural institution Rls. 3,400 million for it. Aftabgardan Institute has fully paid off the amount to the municipality, he said.

He further drew distinctions between the institute and the children's paper by the same name, which he manages.

The next court session is scheduled for Thursday.

### Ebtekar:

## EPO rewards green industries

TEHRAN - Expansion of green industries during the third decade of the Islamic Revolution is indispensable, said Vice President and head of the Environment Protection Organization (EPO) Masoumeh Ebtekar.

Ebtekar said in an interview that specialists of such companies will introduce and commend those industries which contribute to the living environment in a two day seminar in Pardisan protected zone, starting Saturday.

On future plans for cleaning the living environment of the country specially in highly polluted cities, she told Iran News that due to accelerated growth of domestic industrial and development projects, it was necessary to rid the EPO of its stagnant and marginal role in various phases of planning and policy making.

In order to vigorously and efficiently protect the living environment, EPO must achieve its legal power and strength and guide the development process into a right channel. This led to many changes and amendments in the policies, targets and management structure of the organization, she said.

Departments of education, planning and training as well as public participation and planning bureaus have been established. Also the department of natural resources has expanded its operations, and a series of changes were made in EPO's structure and organizational chart as well as in the administrative machinery. The productivity of the organization has also been raised, she said.

On the extent of the EPO's participation in the Third Five-Year Development Plan, she said that one

of the important steps taken by EPO was to launch its national determination master plan for protection of the living environment, where 100 experts have worked for a period of nine months, Ebtekar said.

This is an exceptional work plan which is divided into 9 chapters and will pave the way for the implementation of the third plan.

"We do not allocate a separate budget for the living environment projects because environmental issues are part of the development process and each development project and factory must set up a budget for the evaluation of environmental issues and compliance with the related regulations.

The master plan covers important topics such as water pollution, oil erosion, air pollution, forests, rangelands; educational programs aimed at the preservation of the living environment, and public participation in such ventures.

An extensive campaign is under way to solicit support of the public and non-governmental organizations in matters related to the living environment, she added.

"We are also trying in conjunction with the high council of youth, to promote a love of green space among our youth," she continued.

As for protection of the Persian Gulf, Ebtekar said that some good measures

were adopted and by closely working with the regional organization or protection of marine environment which consists of Persian Gulf littoral states, several training workshops were conducted and steps were taken to concluded protocols for transportation of industrial and dangerous waste in the Persian Gulf.

With regard to the Caspian Sea, she said that a close operation has been launched between its littoral states with the international environment protection organizations to safeguard the sea in the most effective way possible.

"We have called on the littoral states to devise a convention for the Caspian Sea's living environment and have set up a series of standards for that sea which the littoral states are bound to implement," she said.

In reply to the recent atomic bomb tests, she said that from the environmental point of view, these tests may have unpleasant and detrimental impacts. The fact is that living environment agencies including greenspace are very sensitive and concerned about such dangerous activities.

With regard to the pollution in Tehran, she said that air pollution executive commissions have been established in Tehran as well as in the centers of big provinces.
