





TEHRAN - Iran's new Ambassador to Bonn Ahmad Azizi in a meeting with German President Roman Herzog voiced Iran's willingness to expand bilateral relations on the basis of mutual respects.

During the meeting held at the presidential palace in Bonn on Monday, Azizi submitted his credentials, IRNA reported.

The German president in reply expressed hope that Tehran and Bonn by leaving behind the past hard period would further develop mutual ties in an atmosphere free from tension.

Khatami:

Iran's relations with regional countries developing fast

TEHRAN - Iran's President Mohamma Khatami at the meeting with the famous Muslim thinker Zarzavi said here Monday "we extend the hand of cordiality and cooperation with all countries based on mutual respect."

President Khatami expressed pleasure over the swiftly expanding relations with the countries of the region and friendly nations in the Muslim world, IRNA reported.

Referring to the recognized rights of the Muslims both Shiite and Sunni, the president stated that "we have the duty and responsibility towards the religious minorities."

"If there happens to be any problem for the common people be they Shiite or

Strengthening NPT best means to guarantee global peace

TEHRAN - Iranian Foreign Ministry spokesman Mahmoud Mohammadi in New York Monday categorically rejected a baseless claim by the Zionist circles saying that Iran has asked Pakistan to transfer its nuclear technology to Iran.

Saying that the Islamic Republic of Iran basically does not need such programs, Mohammadi pointed out that Iran has advised India and Pakistan not to involve themselves in nuclear test races, IRNA reported from New York.

"The term Islamic bomb in Zionist recent propaganda machinery against Muslim nations is merely a baseless and false propaganda conspiracy," said the Iranian spokesman.

Majlis soon invites government for joint session

TEHRAN - A member of the presiding board of Majlis here on Sunday presented a report to Majlis Speaker Ali Akbar Nateq-Nouri on the performance of Majlis regarding President Mohammad Khatami's administration, and further announced that the Cabinet ministers will soon be invited to a joint session with Majlis in an effort to forge closer Majlis-government

cooperation.

Omidvar Rezaei said in his report that cooperation between Majlis and government started with the speaker's message of congratulations to President Khatami prior to the final counting of votes in presidential election, IRNA reported.

Moreover, he stated, the overwhelming vote of confidence of deputies for the proposed members of Pres-

sunni denominations, it is the responsibility of the government to take appropriate measure to resolve it."

Khatami also the current chairman of the Organization of Islamic Conference (OIC) said, "all Arabs, Muslims and freedom lovers should cooperate closely to defend the legitimate rights of the oppressed Palestinian refugees."

Pointing to the endeavors of Muslim thinkers and philosophers, the president stated "heavy responsibility is being shoudered by the philanthropic scholars," adding that "if we happen to go back to our root, it does not mean we want to stall and dwell in the past but it is done for our identity."

"The root of our identity is, of course, in divine rev-

elations, which is affected by neither time nor place factor due to the fact that the concepts of divine revelations are eternal," said the president.

Khatami then pro-pounded "the effective way to defend Islam would be to show that Islam prevails not only on the individual front but on the social arena as well for the visualization of its humanitarian generosity and humane dignity and honor."

"Muslim thinkers and philosophers should innately believe it and show proper discretion on the time factor in such matters to be able to play pioneering and exceptional role," Khatami said.

"Islamic government is a fortress for all the different schools of thought, and that

the duty goes beyond defending a particular denomination," said the president.

"Our responsibility is to defend the essence of Islam and philanthropic generosity," Khatami highlighted.

"In an Islamic government, even the non-Muslim has dignity and honor and rights and that the establishment of an Islamic government is not only for the Muslims but for the mankind as well so that all can derive full benefit from their individual rights," the president said.

Referring to the enemy stratagem, the president said, "we should not allow the enemy to reap the benefit of the differences, and differing outlooks as a consequence of natural environments and

Iran crowned as world students wrestling champion

TEHRAN - Iranian varsity students, bagging six gold medals and scoring 72 points, won championship of the third international free-style wrestling contests of university students in Ankara.

Turkey ranked second with 62 points and Russia third with 52 in the contests which started at Ataturk stadium last Monday.

Wrestlers from 21 countries including Iran, Belarus, Georgia, France, Croatia, Canada, Japan, Armenia, Russia, Poland, Mexico, Estonia, Brazil, the U.S., Azerbaijan, Ukraine, Lithuania, Mongolia, Finland and Sweden competed in the tournament.

Italian prime minister:

Iran plays a significant role in Middle East

TEHRAN - The fostering of deep ties and dialog between two ancient civilizations of Iran and Italy were stressed at the meeting in New York Monday morning between Italian Prime Minister Romano Prodi and Iran's Foreign Minister Kamal Kharrazi.

On the sidelines of the special twentieth session of the United Nations General Assembly on a new global strategy aimed at eradicating illicit drug crops, the Italian prime minister said Iran plays a significant role in the Middle East region and that Italy gave special significance to a dialog between civilizations," IRNA reported from New York.

Prodi went on to say that "bilateral relations between Iran and Italy should

be based on the deep roots of civilization and culture of the two nations."

The Italian prime minister expressed pleasure over his imminent official visit to the Islamic Republic of Iran. Kharrazi welcomed bilateral cooperation and exchange of views on the issues at regional and international level besides recent developments in matters of bilateral relations between Italy and Iran.

The two sides also reviewed the issues of disarmament conference in Geneva and the latest nuclear tests conducted in India and Pakistan.

The two sides called on the world community to take effective measures in the direction of the endorsement of Non-Proliferation Treaty (NPT) for ensuring peace and stability in the world.

Iran urges OPEC to adopt common strategy

TEHRAN - OPEC members are required to adopt common strategy to protect environment and campaign against levying tax on oil imports by the oil consuming states, Iranian Oil Ministry official Hossein Kazempour Ardehili said on Monday.

Addressing the conference on the prospects of the Organization of Petroleum Exporting Countries (OPEC), he said the Islamic Republic of Iran has put forward the proposal to set up "OPEC bank" to finance OPEC members and help them develop their oil reserves, IRNA reported.

Ardehili said though some believe the OPEC-determined system to fix prices and quotas is out of date, but, the members should have effective coop-

eration to determine the two parameters of price and production level.

The question is how we

should deal with the oil companies in light of their growing presence in the OPEC member states if we did not follow the pricing and quota mechanism," Ardehili said.

He said sharing the quota with the oil companies would decrease the profit of the producing nations.

Ardehili said OPEC's failure lies in the weak international relations among the member states. When the OPEC states are not after a

common objective they are more like competitors rather than partners so they compete in attracting investment and boosting their own production capacity, he said.

He said the ranking within the OPEC is not important, but the states with excessive production have deteriorating impact on the OPEC.

The Islamic Republic of Iran welcomes the decision made by Saudi Arabia and Venezuela in Riyadh in March to cut their oil output by 1.5 million bpd which raised the oil prices by Dlrs.

1.5 per barrel," Ardehili said.

The accord reached in Amsterdam between Saudi Arabia, Venezuela and non-OPEC Mexico on June 4 to cut the total output of the trio by 450,000 bpd fell short of significant impact on the oil market, he said.

"The OPEC members have no excessive production, they are required to modify their legal system concerning the oil industry to attract investment and develop their oil fields to meet the growing demand in future," he said.

Tehran hosts SWAPU gathering

TEHRAN - The second gathering of South West Asian Postal Union (SWAPU) started work here Monday with participation of representatives from Universal Postal Union (UPU) and South West Asian countries.

Addressing the opening session of the five-day seminar, the Minister of Post, Telephone and Telegraph (PTT), Mohammad Reza Aref, touched on the current reforms in the world's postal network and briefed the participants on the measures taken by Iran's PTT Ministry to reform and improve national postal services, IRNA reported.

Despite these measures, unfortunately, the postal ser-

vices have had insufficient growth rate, he said, adding the PTT Ministry is trying to reach desirable levels of service.

He called on the developing countries to take into account their local conditions when trying to improve postal services thus keeping pace with international developments.

The Islamic Republic of Iran, realizing the current reform trend in the international postal system, has started work to improve its own postal services, he added. Aref said that cooperation between postal networks and research and scientific centers has helped Iran with this endeavor.

Dismissing the idea that

electronic mail, telephone and fax are rivals for regular mail, he said that these devices can even increase mail traffic.

Tajik Parliament supports development of relations with Iran

TEHRAN - Speaker of Tajik Parliament Safar-Ali Rajabev said on Monday the Tajik Parliament supports development of relations with the Islamic Republic of Iran especially in economic areas.

In a meeting with Iranian Ambassador to Tajikistan Rasul Mousavi, Rajabev said the two countries have massive grounds for cooperation and Tajikistan is willing to develop industrial cooperation with Iran, IRNA reported from Dushanbe.
