## Tehran, Dublin call for promotion of cooperation

TEHRAN - The visiting head of the Irish Parliament's commission for public auditing, James Mitchel, and head of Iran's Plan and Budget Organization, Mohammad Ali Najafi, discussed promotion of bilateral economic, political and cultural cooperation.

Najafi, also vice-president, said that relations between Iranian and Irish parliaments are at a desirable level and called for measures to be taken to activate parliamentary friendship groups.

The Iranian vice-president added that foreign investment in Iran's Third 5-Year Development Plan will mainly focus on oil and gas projects. Domestic investments will be made in other sectors, he said.

President receives Kuwaiti interior minister

# Regional stability a prerequisite for Persian Gulf development

TEHRAN - President Mohammad Khatami here Wednesday told the visiting Kuwaiti Interior Minister, Sheikh al-Khaled as-Sabah, that security paves the way for development and development consolidates security.

The president expressed hope that the Kuwaiti official's visit will serve as another step to enhance the understanding between Iran and Kuwait, and to further transform it into broad political, economic and security cooperation.

"Today the region more than any other time is in need of security and tranquility, and through cooperation and prudence of all the regional countries, we should remove any causes of tension in the region," IRNA quoted Khatami as saying.

Highlighting the political resolve on part of both countries to expand their bilateral cooperation, the chief executive said "there is no obstacle in the way of expansion of brotherly relations between the two countries, and we hope that these relations serve as a model for

cooperation throughout the region."

The Kuwaiti official conveyed regards from the emir, crown prince and prime minister of Kuwait to Khatami, adding "the friendly and brotherly relations between the two countries have historical roots, and the Kuwaiti government attaches special importance to all-around expansion of its ties with Iran."

Assessing his meetings with the country's officials as fruitful, As-Sabah said that given the political resolve on part of the two sides, Iran-Kuwait cooperation should continue to grow.

The Kuwaiti official referred to security and tranquility as the primary requirement for development of the regional countries, adding that Iran-Kuwait agreements to boost political and security cooperation would also help bilateral economic cooperation as well as regional security.

The Kuwaiti Minister also held talks with Majlis Speaker Ali Akbar Nateq-Nouri who referred to the two countries' commonal-

ities and underlined the Iran-Kuwaiti cooperation in the issues of common borders.

Pointing to special significance Iran attaches to the Kuwaiti role in the region, Nouri stated that "the exchange of visits between the two countries' officials will eliminate most of the ambiguities existed between the two neighboring nations during the past years."

The speaker said that "the Persian Gulf regional nations could have prosperity and healthy growth under the aegis of regional security, tranquility and stability."

Nateq-Nouri also underlined the need for close cooperation and coordination of the regional Muslim countries in an effort to nurture regional security and stability, adding that they should endeavor to defuse any possible move that might cause a breach in the security of the region.

Referring to the memorandum of understanding inked earlier Wednesday between the interior ministers of the two countries, Khaled as-Sabah expressed hope that the agreement would pave the way for the two nations to further expand their cooperation in the area of security issues based on mutual interests. Iran and Kuwait on Wednesday signed a memorandum of understanding to expand their security cooperation.

Based on the agreement, signed by Interior Minister Abdullah Nouri and his Kuwaiti counterpart, the two countries would cooperate in fighting organized crimes as well as drug production and trafficking.

Campaign against counterfeiting government documents and banknotes as well as other forms of economic crimes were other areas of cooperation envisioned in the agreement.

The two countries also agreed to have coordinated efforts in combating trafficking of antiques and arts, weaponry and explosives.

Preventing unauthorized border crossings by citizens of the two countries was another point of agreement.

The two neighbors further agreed to exchange police information and experiences in prosecution of wanted criminals.

## Iran, Germany discuss bilateral ties, Intl. developments

TEHRAN - Minister of Foreign Affairs Kamal Kharrazi and his German counterpart Klaus Kinkel discussed Tehran-Bonn ties as well as key international and regional issues Wednesday.

A joint communiqué issued at the end of the meeting said Kharrazi and Kinkel also reviewed the situation following the nuclear tests by India and Pakistan as well as developments in Afghanistan, Tajikistan, Central Asia, Caspian Sea and the Middle East.

The two foreign ministers especially discussed bilateral questions and agreed that both sides desire to further relations between the two countries, it said.

They asked their officials to prepare another meeting of the two foreign ministers which ought to take place as soon as possible.

"They agreed to do everything possible to resolve outstanding issues and emphasized the need to work together to mend difficulties of the past," it added.

The meeting took place on the sidelines of the U.N. special conference on drugs.

Referring to general circumstances of the country at the initial stages of the newly installed government, President Khatami said "although we may share differences of opinion on the timing of the impeachment of the interior minister with

TEHRAN - President Mohammad Khatami here Wednesday said that Iran and Turkey offer the most suitable route for transfer of gas and oil from Central Asia to Europe.

Receiving the Turkish State Minister, Rafat Sardar Oglu, the president said that expansion of political and economic ties between Iran and Turkey would help regional security.

Khatami added "the region is in need of security, the absence of which does not benefit any of the countries," IRNA reported.

Oglu is currently in Tehran to attend Iran-Turkey joint economic commission session.

Khatami assessed the activation of the

Cabinet studies Majlis motion on interior minister's impeachment

TEHRAN - The cabinet ministers held a session on Wednesday chaired by President Mohammad Khatami to review the issue of the possible impeachment of the Interior Minister Abdullah Nouri by some members of Iran's Islamic Consultative Assembly (Majlis).

Welcoming the issue of impeachment, the president said, "the process of impeachment will help bring about the necessary transparency in the stance."

"I believe that Nouri has the necessary capability to elaborate on the stance and issues related to the Interior Ministry," the chief executive stated.

Referring to general circumstances of the country at the initial stages of the newly installed government, President Khatami said "although we may share differences of opinion on the timing of the impeachment of the interior minister with

some of the Majlis deputies, we hope that with the goodwill of the Majlis deputies and their alertness, the consequences would tilt to the benefit of the country, the government and the people."

Rafsanjani:

Iran follows policy to reinforce relations with

neighboring states

TEHRAN - Chairman of the Expediency Council Akbar Hashemi Rafsanjani said on Wednesday Iran is willing to reinforce relations with neighboring states especially in the Persian Gulf.

In a meeting with outgoing Ambassador of the United Arab Emirates to Iran Ahmad Mohammad Borheimah, Rafsanjani said the level of Iran-UAE relations and cooperation is not satisfactory and the two countries are required to develop friendly relations and exercise foresight to remove the current misunderstanding, IRNA reported.

He pointed to the issue of Iranian islands and said negotiations should be followed seriously to remove the misunderstanding through bilateral talks.

Rafsanjani said, "the alien countries, which are not the friends of either UAE or Iran, should not be allowed to take advantage of this issue for their political ends."

Borheimah expressed pleasure with the outcome of his mission to Iran and said he is leaving Iran with excellent memory.

The ambassador said Iran and the UAE are two Muslim states and the two countries officials are working to remove the differences.

He hoped that the differences would be resolved through negotiations.

TEHRAN - Iran welcome any OPEC decision in support of market stability

TEHRAN - Iran welcomes any OPEC decision in support of oil market stability, said Hojjatollah Ghani Fard, National Iranian Oil Company's (NIOC) director for international affairs.

Ghani Fard told Iran News that the oil market will improve through the collective cooperation of OPEC and non-OPEC producers.

He maintained that by and large, members of the

Organization of Petroleum Exporting Countries are complying with their production quotas but added that over production by certain members leads to lower prices for OPEC as well as independent producers.

"Overproduction is not the only reason for weak oil prices," he said, adding "we cannot blame OPEC alone for lower prices, and diminished demand. The Southeast Asian financial crisis has also played a significant role in bringing prices down."

Ghani Fard considers the recent efforts of Saudi Arabia, Venezuela and Mexico to expand their market shares in U.S. to be a positive move which would help stabilize oil prices worldwide.

Cooperation between OPEC and independent producers are beneficial to all oil producing countries.

He also stated that the increase in the cost of transporting oil is caused partially by unauthorized overproduction by certain OPEC members, but added that another reason is that a large number of oil tankers are old and need frequent and major repairs which reduces the number of seaworthy vessels at any given time and leads to higher transportation costs.

"Iran's new policy is to increase its production capacity," he said, adding "the recent oil and gas projects,

offered through international tenders, are part of this new strategy."

He also emphasized that the contracts being offered by Iran are designed to safeguard the nation's interests, unlike those drawn up prior to the 1979 Islamic Revolution.

He reiterated that transfer of technology is part and parcel of the contracts, but added that Iran recognizes the fact that foreign investors have the right to expect a fair return on their investments.

He said the new projects, including the Neka-Tehran pipeline are being offered on the build-operate-transfer basis which will guarantee interests of both sides of the agreement.
