



President:

Islam flourished through dialog

TEHRAN - President Mohammad Khatami said on Monday that Muslim nations are the strongest and the wealthiest in the world in terms of spiritual and material resources.

Addressing the participants of the international conference on Islamic unity, President Khatami said despite the material and spiritual strength, the Islamic nations do not occupy the place they deserve on the international scene, IRNA reported.

The Muslim nations have

common cultural grounds which bring them together regardless of their race, history and nationality, the president said.

The common culture shared by the Muslim nations can serve to reinforce solidarity which they badly need, President Khatami reiterated.

On different interpretations of Islam, President Khatami said the differences are rooted in the different social historical, psychological and environmental parameters.

"We should not think that the differences may bring us to collapse, but, it is a natural course."

"We should make the differences become the cause of promotion and development and not the cause of tension," President Khatami said in reference to the two branches of Islam, Shi'ite and Sunni.

The president said the colonialist powers have misused the differences in religions throughout the history and they have fanned the flames of religious dis-

putes for their own interests. He said the loss the Islamic world has incurred from the religious difference is terrible and irreparable.

The Muslim nations are expected to find their own place in the world thanks to the spiritual reserves, extraordinary material resources and special status in terms of manpower and young work force, the president said.

The Muslim world needs inner development, the thinkers of the Muslim nations should work for a better future and prosperity, he said.

"We should avoid alienation and should not think that what the Westerners have achieved is the ultimate stage of social life," he said.

President Khatami said, "today, the political and economic structure of the West views the Muslim world as its rival and therefore it does not want to see solidarity prevailing among the Muslim nations."

"No religion, no religious school has invited the human being to peace and coexistence to the extent that Islam has done. We are men of peace but not surrenders to bullies and abusers," he said.

"We are men of dialogue, Islam has flourished through dialogue and embraced the other doctrines, though non-Islamic," he said.

Russia to brief Iran over Caspian Sea deal

TEHRAN - Russian First Deputy Minister of Foreign Affairs Boris Pastukhov is to arrive here on Friday to offer explanations to Iranian officials on a deal signed by Russia and Kazakhstan recently on the Caspian Sea legal regime.

According to the informed sources at the Iranian Foreign Ministry Pastukhov is to hold talks with his Iranian counterpart Morteza Sarmadi and Foreign Minister Kamal Kharrazi, IRNA reported.

Kremlin spokesman Sergei Yastrzhembsky told reporters in Moscow on Monday that the visit to Iran of the Russian deputy foreign minister aimed to exchange views on the issues related to the Caspian Sea.

Yastrzhembsky said that Kremlin is aware that Iran and Turkmenistan are not happy with the deal reached between his country and Kazakhstan on the Caspian Sea.

He said that Russia and Kazakhstan have necessary flexibility towards the issue, considering the need for collective exploitation of the sea by all the littoral states.

Italy ready to contribute in implementation of development projects in Iran

TEHRAN - Italian Foreign Trade Minister Augusto Fantozzi said in Rome on Monday that Iran-Italy joint economic commission is to resume work in Tehran from July 25 following years of inactivity.

The Iranian co-president of the commission is to be Mines and Metals Minister Eshaq Jahangiri and his Italian counterpart would be Fantozzi.

Fantozzi told IRNA in Rome that the commission is to order offering insurance guarantees for export of more than three billion dollars worth of goods to Iran.

He described Italian Prime Minister Romano Prodi's recent visit to Tehran as "successful" and said that relations between Tehran and Rome have entered a practical phase of action.

He said the commission should determine peculiarities of the new phase of such relations.

Fantozzi said that Italy is eager to contribute to implementation of the energy, petrochemical, steel, mechanical and telecommunication projects in Iran.

He said that prior to conclusion of the joint commission session, an Iranian delegation, headed by Industries Minister Gholamreza Shafeie, would visit Italy.

A protocol is to be signed by the two countries,

said Fantozzi, adding that Iranian and Italian experts are busy preparing its content and provisions.

He said the projects for building docks in Iran's Bandar Abbas region (Hormuzgan Province) and for manufacturing Augusta helicopters would be implemented following Tehran-Rome joint economic commission's decision in that respect.

Iran's success in paying off all its due payments on time made Italians call it a solvent payer, said Fantozzi, adding that this very factor has been influential in Iranians' assessment of Tehran-Rome relations.

Elsewhere in his remarks Fantozzi referred to Italy's investment in Iran and said the ground is prepared for Italy's contribution to implementation of projects in Iran's oil sector more than any other sectors and Italian National Oil Company (ENI) is busy holding talks with Iranians on the same issue.

Such companies as Techimonte and Technipetrole in Italy can contribute to Iran's petrochemical activities, said Fantozzi, adding that foundry, mechanics and telecommunications are among other areas in Iran to which Italy can contribute.

Italtel is now holding talks with Iranian telecommunications officials on cellular telephones, he added.

Italian skin processing

union had earlier contributed to qualitative improvement of Iran's leather exported to Italy and is now ready to help certain Iranian small and medium-sized leather companies, he added.

Referring to talks with his Iranian counterpart on airport, road, infrastructural affairs and tourism related subjects and to a cooperation agreement signed by Italian Foreign Trade Institute and Iran's Exports Promotion Center for offering training courses to experts, Fantozzi said that cooperation between Iran and Italy has entered into a phase which is beyond what was already expected.

He expressed hope that trade relations between Tehran and Rome would drastically expand and predicted that volume of mutual transactions would equal that of last year, that is more than Drs 2.7 billion.

He said that U.S.' withdrawal from D'Amato bill and easing its fulfillment by European companies are due to the new policies adopted by Iran and the pressures exerted on the U.S. by the European Union (EU).

Since the beginning, said Fantozzi, Italy was against imposition of any kind of unilateral sanctions. He said Italian companies were suffering from implementation of the D'Amato bill.

Italy's stance is transparent and the country acted soundly vis-a-vis both the U.S. and Iran, concluded Fantozzi.

Iran, Pakistan explore avenues to broaden economic ties

TEHRAN - Iran and Pakistan explored fresh avenues for promotion of trade exchanges between the two countries in the course of the first Iran-Pakistan joint trade council which was opened in Bandar Anzali, north of Iran, Sunday.

The meeting was attended by heads of the two countries' chambers of commerce as well as that of the Economic Cooperation Organization (ECO), IRNA reported.

At the end of the session, Secretary General of ECO Chamber Mohammad Reza Karbasi said that during the meeting the two sides expressed dissatisfaction over the low volume of bilateral trade and called for optimum utilization of potential in an effort to broaden bilateral economic and trade cooperation.

With the rise in the volume of trade between Iran and Pakistan, ECO will realize its objectives, Karbasi said, adding that support for the two countries' chambers within the framework of developing trade exchanges and joint ventures, will also help develop such ties.

The two sides also proposed removal of trade barriers in different areas of commerce and investment which have affected trade exchanges as a whole, he said.

As for permitting Pakistani trucks to gain access to Central Asia via Iran's transit highway, he said that given the importance of Iran's transit highway, Tehran is ready to provide Islamabad with all the required facilities in this connection.

Formulation of practical strategies to forge a positive trade balance between the two countries and removal of trade barriers were among other issues reviewed in the expert discussions in the three industry, investment and transport committees, Karbasi added.

The two sides also agreed on exchange of trade and commercial delegations and setting up of international industrial exhibitions in both countries.

Wholesale price index up 13.3 pc

TEHRAN - The wholesale price index of goods for the Iranian month of Khordad (May 21-June 21) registered a jump of 13.3 percent compared to that of the similar period last year.

The announcement was made by Central Bank's Statistics Department which added that the index stood at 731.7, also showing a jump of 1.1 percent compared to that of the previous month, IRNA reported.

Wholesale price indices on the average for the first quarter of the Iranian year (started March 21) registered a 13.6 percent jump compared to that of same period last year.

Increase in prices of fresh fruits was the major contributor to the jump in the price index, the report added.

According to the statistics for the month of Khordad, the price indices of foodstuff jumped 21.5 percent, of synthetics (with respect to the primary ma-

Addressing the participants of the international conference on Islamic unity, President Khatami said despite the material and spiritual strength, the Islamic nations do not occupy the place they deserve on the international scene, IRNA reported.

The Muslim nations have

common cultural grounds which bring them together regardless of their race, history and nationality, the president said.

The common culture shared by the Muslim nations can serve to reinforce solidarity which they badly need, President Khatami reiterated.

On different interpretations of Islam, President Khatami said the differences are rooted in the different social historical, psychological and environmental parameters.

"We should not think that the differences may bring us to collapse, but, it is a natural course."

"We should make the differences become the cause of promotion and development and not the cause of tension," President Khatami said in reference to the two branches of Islam, Shi'ite and Sunni.

The president said the colonialist powers have misused the differences in religions throughout the history and they have fanned the flames of religious dis-

putes for their own interests. He said the loss the Islamic world has incurred from the religious difference is terrible and irreparable.

The Muslim nations are expected to find their own place in the world thanks to the spiritual reserves, extraordinary material resources and special status in terms of manpower and young work force, the president said.

The Muslim world needs inner development, the thinkers of the Muslim nations should work for a better future and prosperity, he said.

"We should avoid alienation and should not think that what the Westerners have achieved is the ultimate stage of social life," he said.

President Khatami said, "today, the political and economic structure of the West views the Muslim world as its rival and therefore it does not want to see solidarity prevailing among the Muslim nations."

"No religion, no religious school has invited the human being to peace and coexistence to the extent that Islam has done. We are men of peace but not surrenders to bullies and abusers," he said.

"We are men of dialogue, Islam has flourished through dialogue and embraced the other doctrines, though non-Islamic," he said.

Russia to brief Iran over Caspian Sea deal

TEHRAN - Russian First Deputy Minister of Foreign Affairs Boris Pastukhov is to arrive here on Friday to offer explanations to Iranian officials on a deal signed by Russia and Kazakhstan recently on the Caspian Sea legal regime.

According to the informed sources at the Iranian Foreign Ministry Pastukhov is to hold talks with his Iranian counterpart Morteza Sarmadi and Foreign Minister Kamal Kharrazi, IRNA reported.

Kremlin spokesman Sergei Yastrzhembsky told reporters in Moscow on Monday that the visit to Iran of the Russian deputy foreign minister aimed to exchange views on the issues related to the Caspian Sea.

Yastrzhembsky said that Kremlin is aware that Iran and Turkmenistan are not happy with the deal reached between his country and Kazakhstan on the Caspian Sea.

He said that Russia and Kazakhstan have necessary flexibility towards the issue, considering the need for collective exploitation of the sea by all the littoral states.

Italy ready to contribute in implementation of development projects in Iran

TEHRAN - Italian Foreign Trade Minister Augusto Fantozzi said in Rome on Monday that Iran-Italy joint economic commission is to resume work in Tehran from July 25 following years of inactivity.

Iran, Pakistan explore avenues to broaden economic ties

TEHRAN - Iran and Pakistan explored fresh avenues for promotion of trade exchanges between the two countries in the course of the first Iran-Pakistan joint trade council which was opened in Bandar Anzali, north of Iran, Sunday.

The meeting was attended by heads of the two countries' chambers of commerce as well as that of the Economic Cooperation Organization (ECO), IRNA reported.

At the end of the session, Secretary General of ECO Chamber Mohammad Reza Karbasi said that during the meeting the two sides expressed dissatisfaction over the low volume of bilateral trade and called for optimum utilization of potential in an effort to broaden bilateral economic and trade cooperation.

With the rise in the volume of trade between Iran and Pakistan, ECO will realize its objectives, Karbasi said, adding that support for the two countries' chambers within the framework of developing trade exchanges and joint ventures, will also help develop such ties.

The two sides also proposed removal of trade barriers in different areas of commerce and investment which have affected trade exchanges as a whole, he said.

As for permitting Pakistani trucks to gain access to Central Asia via Iran's transit highway, he said that given the importance of Iran's transit highway, Tehran is ready to provide Islamabad with all the required facilities in this connection.
