

Iran, Kuwait call for promotion of bilateral ties

TEHRAN - Senior Kuwaiti officials have called for further promotion of relations with Iran.

At the end of his diplomatic mission to Kuwait, the Iranian Ambassador, Ghofamali Sanati, held separate talks with officials at the Kuwaiti Justice Ministry, Ministry of Foreign Affairs and the son of Emir of Kuwait.

Further expansion of cooperation between the two governments, particularly in political, trade and cultural fields were among the subjects reviewed at the meetings.

People appreciate real worth of government administrators

TEHRAN - The Leader of the Islamic Revolution, Ayatollah Ali Khamenei, assured the cabinet ministers that people appreciate the real worth of the administration and of government administrators.

Addressing President Mohammad Khatami and his cabinet ministers on the first day of the government week (Aug. 24-31) here Monday, the Leader said the popular support for the administration is a divine asset that could be forever safeguarded by sincere and well-intentioned efforts, IRNA reported.

Sectarianism, extremism run counter to Islamic principles

TEHRAN - Iranian Parliament Speaker Ali Akbar Nateq Nouri said here on Monday that sectarianism, extremism and violence run counters to Islamic principles.

In a meeting with grand mufti of Lebanon Muhammad Rashid Qabbani, Nateq Nouri said the enemies are working hard to overshadow the common goals of the Muslims by magnifying minor differences in a bid to reach their ominous objectives and therefore the Muslim and Islamic states should exercise vigilance, IRNA reported.

He said world Muslims are seen as an entirety in Iranian diplomacy and this is the reason for global arrogance's animosity against Iran.

Nateq Nouri said the only way to liberate Palestine is unity of the Muslims in accordance with the lofty teachings of Islam and Prophet Mohammad (peace be upon him).

The grand mufti of Lebanon briefed Nateq Nouri on the resistance of the Lebanese people and said the unity of the Muslims and support of the Islamic states are the only means to deal with the Zionist expansionism.

The leader of Dar el-Fatwa of Lebanon appreciated Iran's support for the Muslims in Lebanon and called Iran as a model Islamic state.

Qabbani arrived in Tehran on Sunday.

Industrial goods export up 40 pc

TEHRAN - The export of industrial goods, manufactured by units affiliated to the Industries Ministry rose from Dls 76 million in 1989, showing an average 40 percent growth, said deputy industries minister for economic and financial affairs Ebrahim Bahadorani here on Monday.

Bahadorani told IRNA that the country imported goods worth Dls 2,919 billion last year against Dls 2,722 bn imports in 1989.

In the said period, he said, the country in return for every 100 dollars worth of imports exported 2.8 dollars worth of goods but at the same time the ratio of export to import reached 38 to 100 dollars last year.

The industries sector imported Dls 2,919 billion worth of goods last year, the deputy industries minister said.

More cities to be supplied with gas facilities

TEHRAN - Projects concerning laying of city natural gas pipelines in 45 cities are to become operational during the government week (August 24-31) or by late March next year, said deputy oil minister for gas affairs Hamidollah Mohammadnejad.

He said that in line with policies to replace fossil fuels with natural gas, the refineries of Vali-e Asr, Kangiran, Sarkhan and Bidbandi have raised their daily gas refining capacities up to 150 million cubic meters, in the past five months, up 12.5 percent compared to the corresponding period last year.

795 kilometers of 30 to 56-inch high pressure gas pipelines have been designed and produced between August 1997 and July 1998, said

Mohammadnejad, adding that this raised the total production of the domestically made high pressure gas pipelines to 11,240 kilometers.

He added that the length of the total city gas networks has amounted to 44,632 kilometers and the number of city gas subscriptions to 2,630,392.

According to Mohammadnejad 305,469 new subscribers were supplied with natural gas service within the period, thus raising the number of gas subscribers throughout the country to 3,286,951.

At present, 5,124,000 families all over the country enjoy natural gas facilities, he added.

By the year end, Mohammadnejad said that 50 billion cubic meters of natural gas are to be refined and distributed and another 27 billion cubic meters is to be injected into oil wells this year. Under a new plan, he added, the volume of natural gas offered to the gas operated power plants would rise to 21 billion cubic meters this year from 16.3 billion cubic meters last year, showing a 25 percent growth.

As for plans to replace gas oil with natural gas at the industry sector, he said the National Iranian Gas Company (NIGC) is planning to supply more natural gas to 500 industrial units in the first phase this year and to 600 new subscribers in downstream section annually in a period of three years, he added.

Once the project is fully implemented by the year end, he added, 7.5 million cubic meters of natural gas would be delivered to the industrial

UK partner joins Balal project

TEHRAN - Premier Oil of the UK has signed a joint venture agreement with Canada's Bow Valley under which it will fund 75 percent of the estimated Dls 150 million cost to develop Iran's offshore Balal field.

The British partner follows Indonesian firm, Bakrie, pulling out the project. A previous joint venture with UK engineers Peter Frishmann also fell apart because of previous U.S. sanctions threats that made financing the deal difficult, IRNA reported from London.

In his talks to the visiting group he also condemned the U.S. attacks against Afghanistan and Sudan as an example of state terrorism.

He said the U.S. missile attacks on the two countries is violation of the territories of the two countries, and added that the Islamic Republic condemns the act on the strength of established international conventions.

He said what has taken place in Sudan and Afghanistan is by no way accepted by independent and free-loving people in the world, adding that it is not acceptable that a government relying on its military might attack another country and kill its innocent people.

He noted that independent nations of the world would never accept such wrongdoings and the Muslim and valiant nation of Iran has always bravely condemned such actions.

Terming the American attacks against Sudan and Afghanistan as a criminal act, the Leader said: "I do not know Osama bin Laden and I do not condone killing local and civilian people in Tanzania and Kenya, but the military action of the U.S. against Sudan and Afghanistan is as much condemned as killing civilians in Kenya and Tanzania."

The Leader also said as far as the Islamic Iran is concerned the U.S. attacks against Sudan and Afghanistan is as much condemned as the killing of civilians by the Taliban in Mazar-i-Sharif of Afghanistan.

Using the investments, the NIGC is expected to raise its daily gas refining capacity to 44 million cubic meters in two years' time, he said.

The NIGC is also to set up more than six gas relay stations and admit 330,000 new subscribers in downstream section annually in a period of three years, he added.

Giving some details on the projects, Hojjati said that new lanes would be added to Tehran-Mashhad road, of which the Neishabour-Mashhad stretch would become a freeway.

Hojjati also referred to the ongoing construction of airports in Semnan and Shahrood, adding that the Shahrood airport would be inaugurated in the near future.

Iranian soccer club coach, best in Asia in July

TEHRAN - The Asian Football Confederation in a statement issued in Kuala Lumpur Monday declared head-coach of Esteghlal soccer club of Iran Nasser Hejazi as the best in Asia in the month of July.

Esteghlal club, coached by Hejazi, won the first title in the national soccer league in Iran in the past season, IRNA reported from Kuala Lumpur.

The statement further described Hejazi, formerly serving as the goalkeeper of Iran's national team, as having been quite successful in directing Esteghlal to victory. It further said Esteghlal club, which along with Pirooz is one of most popular teams in Iran, has managed to make its way into Asian league thanks to Hejazi's leadership.

President:

Iran expects Pakistan to secure release of diplomats

in Afghanistan.

Earlier on Monday, Foreign Minister Kamal Kharrazi told the Pakistani state minister for foreign affairs that Pakistan's performance in relation to the Iranian diplomats taken hostage by Taliban in Afghanistan is unjustifiable. "Pakistan's explanations are not convincing at all," he added.

Kharrazi said the Iranian people and government are seeking immediate release of the Iranian diplomats and the IRNA reporter by the Taliban.

The tape recording of a telephone conversation between Iranian consulate in Mazar-i-Sharif and the Foreign Ministry proved that the Iranian diplomats were present at the consulate when Taliban overran it, he said, adding that any other claim by the Taliban in this respect is sheer lie.

Kharrazi said, "what is happening in Afghanistan have brought suffering for the Afghan people and posed threat to the security and stability of the region."

"The Islamic Republic of

Kanju said Pakistan has done what it could to secure the release of the Iranian diplomats and would go ahead with new efforts to this end.

Faezeh Hashemi:
Grounds prepared for expansion of Tehran-Baghdad ties

TEHRAN - Member of Parliament Ms. Faezeh Hashemi said here Sunday that common religious and cultural points between the Ira-

nians and Iraqis lay the foundation for expansion of Tehran-Baghdad relations.

She made the remark in a meeting with the Iraqi Charge d'Affaires to Tehran Salah Nouri al-Samarrai, IRNA reported.

Ms. Hashemi who is also head of Muslim Women's Sports Solidarity Council added that the Islamic Republic's sports policy is promoting global peace and understanding among nations.

She said that the two countries, through exchange of experience, will make outstanding achievements in the area of women's political and social activities.

Referring to the latest developments in Karabakh, the Armenian foreign minister said, "unfortunately it is more than two years that the negotiations on the disputed enclave have stalled and we think that the reason for this is the pre-conditions set by Azerbaijan for negotiations."

He reiterated that Armenia is ready to begin negotiations without any pre-conditions, adding "we are hopeful that after the next presidential elections in Azerbaijan, some changes will take place and we can resume negotiations."

Welcoming his Armenian counterpart at the airport, Kharrazi said, "Armenia is an important neighbor and our priority is to expand relations with our neighbors."

"We like to help resolve the crises in the region and to strengthen peace in the region, and this holds true for the Caucasus," the Iranian foreign minister added.

"We will once again declare our readiness to assist in resolving the Karabakh crisis in our talks with the Armenian foreign minister," Kharrazi said.

He further said "cooperation between Iran, Armenia and Greece is an important means by which we can achieve peace and security in the region."
