



MPs approve first non-governmental bank

TEHRAN - The parliament here on Sunday approved the general outlines of the plan to authorize the establishment of cooperatives bank.

If the plan passes through the second round of parliament debates, the government would receive authorization to prepare the grounds for establishment of non-governmental cooperatives bank by firms, unions and cooperatives.

According to the plan, the private sector can hold up to 49 percent of the bank's total shares, thus leaving the cooperatives with the controlling share of at least 51 percent in the bank.

Leader addresses families of martyrs:

Mohammadi:

Religion saves a nation from its enemies

TEHRAN - The Leader of the Islamic Revolution, Ayatollah Ali Khamenei, here on Sunday termed martyrs and their families as "the bright lights of history and the Islamic system," adding "based on religious principles, there is no value loftier for a human being than to willfully sacrifice his life and existence for sublime divine ideals."

Addressing an audience of families of the martyrs of the armed forces and the construction jihad corps, the Leader further highlighted the impact of martyrdom on the progress of nations, and stated "any nation which learns the art of martyrdom is forever proud, not ever being overcome by any power."

"This is because any nation which can bring its youth, men and women to come to terms with dying in the path of God, will never be affected by threats, seductions, propaganda and military campaigns by the enemies, and thus will never submit to the powerful," IRNA reported.

Stating that the martyrs are responsible for the Iranian nation's resistance to pressures by the world arrogance, Ayatollah Khamenei added "the arrogance has failed and will fail in all its assaults on the Islamic Iran."

"Various plots of satanic powers including economic sanctions, propaganda cam-

paigns, baseless accusations, efforts to create discord in the nation and encroachment on people's faith would be frustrated and this is all owed to the blood of martyrs."

The Leader further referred to those attached to material attractions of life as the source of adversity for nations and governments, adding "it's religion that secures the life and afterlife of the people, and saves a nation from its enemies."

Greece, Iran agree to sign tourism cooperation protocol

TEHRAN - The director of the international relations department of Iran's Tourism Organization (ITO), Morteza Tale, and his Greek counterpart Athanasis Zarakoglu underlined the necessity of signing a tourism protocol agreement between Athens and Tehran to promote tourism cooperation.

In a meeting in Athens, the director of international relations of the Greek Tourism Organization (EOT), said Iran with its many archaeological sites and ancient culture and history could take a central place in world tourism,

Zarakoglu stressed that in order to promote tourism in Iran, Tehran must facilitate issuing of visas to foreign tourists, and publish tourism literature on Iran in different languages.

On his part, Tale expressed the ITO's readiness to sign a bilateral protocol with the Greek side to promote tourism between the two countries and with other nations.

He pointed out that Iran is a bridge between Central Asia and the Middle East and occupies a central geographic and geo-political position.

Tale said cooperation in the tourism sector will contribute to world peace among peoples.

SNSC secretary:

Investment in Caspian Sea requires unanimous legal regime

TEHRAN - Secretary of Supreme National Security Council (SNSC) Hassan Rowhani said on Sunday the foreign companies making investments in the Caspian Sea should know that their investments lack security until final approval of the legal regime by the littoral states.

In a meeting with Russian Ambassador to Iran, Konstantin Shuvalev, Rowhani said, "the Islamic Republic of Iran is willing to fairly divide the Caspian Sea with a consensus among all neighboring states," IRNA reported. Iran opposes interference of foreign countries in the Caspian Sea and insists on protection of environment and non-military nature of the Caspian Sea,

Rowhani said.

He said drawing up of the legal regime for the Caspian Sea by the littoral states is an area of cooperation between Iran and Russia which serves the peace and security of the region.

On situation in Afghanistan, Rowhani said the current Afghan crisis has posed threat to regional stability and increased drug trafficking in the world.

He said the United Nations Security Council is required to take decisive measures to deal with Taliban crimes and their negligence towards the international law and human rights.

Rowhani said setting up a broad-based government with participation of all Af-

TEHRAN - Three Iranians specializing in books for the young received honorary diplomas of the sixth international congress 'book for young people,' held in the Indian capital of New Delhi.

Hassan Ebrahim took the award for translating 'the winter and the war', Mohammad Reza Yousefi for writing 'a star a giant' and Vida Shokri for her illustrations for the book 'the stories of my mom and me'.

The congress, sponsored by the International Board on Books for Young people (IBBY), was held September 19-24.

IBBY was formed in Switzerland in 1958 and is considered one of the most important international organizations active in the field of books for children and young adults. Its congress is held every alternate year.

Armenian official lauds Iran's industrial progress

ISFAHAN - The Armenian Deputy Industry Minister Mosesz Zavarian lauded Iran's industrial achievements while inspecting Mubarak Steel Complex in Isfahan.

He said that Iran has a bright and successful future possessing such a huge complex.

He also expressed hope that the Mubarak products will become available in the Armenian market.

Zavarian was briefed on the various production lines and the computer center of the complex.

The Mubarak Steel Complex production reached 1,173 million tons of steel slabs and 983,000 tons of hot and 334,000 tons of cold steel sheets, respectively, in the first half of the current Iranian year (started March, 21).

TEHRAN - President Mohammad Khatami here Sunday inaugurated a ceremony on the occasion of the International Tourism Day and Tourism Week in Iran.

Underlining the importance of tourism industry, the president called for working out a strategy and key policy to promote this industry, IRNA reported.

Referring to Iran's significant position in the area of tourism, he stressed that while the Islamic Republic of Iran is among the major 10 countries of the world with regards to historical sites and monuments, the country's share of tourism revenue is very meager.

Tourism industry plays key role in the economy without oil, he stated calling for greater efforts to develop the industry and to remove the existing obstacles in this regard.

The Islamic Republic while enjoying rich cultural heritage and ancient civi-

lization is also situated at an strategic geographical location, he said adding that Iran is a bridge between Eastern and Western civilizations.

Prior to the president's speech, Mohammad Moazzedin, deputy culture and Islamic guidance minister and head of Tourism Organization briefed the audience on tourism in Iran and world.

September 28, the International Tourism Day, marks the start of the Tourism Week in Iran.

Moazzedin said that dialog among civilizations through the channel of tourism will strengthen social bonds among different nations of the world.

He said tourism will enhance understanding among different nations, thus expanding peaceful international relations.

National petrochemical conference kicks off

TEHRAN - The fifth conference of the executives and experts of the Iranian petrochemical industries opened here on Sunday.

The two-day conference is aimed to explore ways of increasing the industries production, boosting product quality, safety and skill level of the work-force in the industry.

The secretary of the conference, Mohammad Hassan Peivandi, told IRNA on Sunday that the output of the country's eight active petrochemical complexes would reach 12 million tons for the year (the current Iranian year started March 21).

Upon the completion of another 10 petrochemical units by the end of the Third Economic Development Plan (year 2004), the country's petrochemical output would reach 20 million tons annually, Peivandi added.

The official further spoke of plans to construct some giant petrochemical complexes which would be fed by the South Pars gas field. The completion of the said projects would run into the fourth economic development plan, he said.

On the quality of the petrochemical products, Peivandi said that the Isfahan petrochemical complex and some of the petrochemical units in Kharq, Arak, Imam Khomeini port and Shiraz have received ISO-9000 certification while a unit of the Isfahan complex has also managed to receive ISO-14000 certificate.

Energy minister:

7 giant dams under construction

GACHSARAN, Kohkiluyeh-Boyer Ahmad - Minister of Energy Habibollah Bitaraf said here Friday evening that seven giant dams are currently under construction in different parts of the country.

He added that the dams which are at different stage of construction include, Karoun 3 and 4, Masjed Soleyman, Martyr Abbaspour, Karkheh, Shoushtar and Seymareh, IRNA reported.

When operational, the dams will totally generate some 8,000 megawatts of energy which will be equal to one quarter of the current amount of energy produced.

Meanwhile, addressing officials in charge of construction of Kowsar dam in this southwestern province, the energy minister stressed that his ministry gives top priority to putting into operation the dam.

Some Rls 100 billion has

so far been allocated to construction of the dam which will become operational next year, he added.

Referring to strategic geographical location of Kowsar dam, he noted that the dam will provide water for hundreds of hectares of farm lands and drinking water for some two million people.

Meanwhile, the energy minister said in Shiraz, capital of Fars Province on Saturday that to speed up the completion of dams under construction, the Energy Ministry will sell bonds and embark on foreign borrowing to compensate for its budget shortage in the current Iranian year (started March, 21).

He added that the bonds will be offered to the public, starting mid October.

Speaking at the inaugural ceremony of the 'Salman Farsi' dam water

diversion project, Bitaraf said that the investment proceeds from the sale of bonds will be distributed on a regional basis and each province's share in the investment will be proportional to the revenues of the bonds.

The energy minister further said that the interest accrued on investments will be, at the minimum, 20 percent annually, stressing that purchase of the bonds will be a good opportunity for the public to participate in these large development projects.

He Energy Ministry plans to borrow Dls 300 million this year, which will meet most of its foreign exchange needs, Bitaraf said. He minister added that the foreign exchange borrowing will enable the construction of three large dams, one of which is in the Fars Province.

The three groups of food, beverage and tobacco, health and medicine and housing, heating and electricity have shown the highest increase in the index.

Iran welcomes tourists from Central Asia

TEHRAN - Iran's Ambassador in Uzbekistan Mohsen Pak-Aeen at the fourth international silk-road tourist exhibition in Tashkent said, "Iranian embassies all over the world inclusive of those in Central Asian republics are ready to issue tourist visas with no delay."

Pak-Aeen invited the Central Asian republic tourists and businessmen to visit Iran.

The Iranian ambassador said that free trade zones in Iran have great economic potentialities and can provide tourists with much cheaper accommodations than other places in the world.

An Iranian tourist organization has participated in the fair.

French foreign minister:

France to boost presence in Iran

TEHRAN - French Foreign Minister Herbert Vedrine told an Arab newspaper that France will have a stronger presence in Iran than it had in the past.

In an interview with daily "Al-Sharq al-Awsat" published Sunday, Vedrine said "we noticed the changes which occurred in Iran last year with the election of the new president after the elections which were distinguished with high participation," IRNA reported from Athens.

Commenting on the opening between Europe and Iran, Vedrine said during his visit to Tehran last August it struck to him that France should have "a tangible presence in Iran that should surpass the level in the past" both on the political and economic level.

He said the opening was in the interest of Iran and the region as a whole and as well as for European-Iranian ties.

Commenting on the issue of the apostate writer Salman Rushdie, the French foreign minister described President Khatami's recent statement on the matter as "a very positive development."

The French foreign minister also said Paris welcomes the recent decision by Saudi Arabia to scale down its diplomatic ties with the Taliban militia and called on other countries which have recognized Taliban to follow suit.

"We welcome the steps taken by Saudi Arabia...and we hope that other countries which have recognized Taliban will take steps," Vedrine told international Arab daily "Al-Hayat" in an interview published Sunday.

He was replying to a question on the recent Saudi decision to expel Taliban's representative from Riyadh and withdraw its own charge d'affaires from Kabul.

Besides Saudi Arabia, Pakistan and the UAE are the only other countries which have recognized the Taliban militia. Vedrine said Saudi Arabia has clarified its position that although Riyadh has recognized Taliban it does not support the militia movement.

The French foreign minister said Paris supports the United Nations' efforts to resolve the Afghan crisis and called on the neighboring countries of Afghanistan as well as domestic forces inside Afghanistan to "show good will."

He described the current situation in Afghanistan as "dangerous and complicated" and called on Pakistan and neighboring states to do more to defuse the situation.

general of the foreign nationals and expatriates department at Interior Ministry Hassanali Ebrahimi said here on Sunday in an address to a group of Iraqi refugees

that Iran has always been a safe haven for foreign refugees during 20 years after triumph of the 1979 Islamic Revolution in the country.

Ebrahimi said despite enduring tough economic and social hardships caused as a result of Afghan and Iraqi refugees' presence in Islamic Iran, the country treated the refugees with compassion and did not force them to repatriate.

He added that Iraqi refugees are Iranians' brothers and sisters, considering their problem as their own.

He expressed hope that Iraqi refugees would return home voluntarily following restoration of calm and security in Iraq.

Iran to organize cultural

programs in India

TEHRAN - Iran's Culture and Islamic Guidance Ministry is to organize three cultural programs in India in November and February, said Deputy Minister of Culture and Islamic Guidance Ahmad Masjid Jamei.

Masjid Jamei, who had earlier visited India heading a cultural delegation, told IRNA that among the programs to be organized by the ministry were a meeting of the Persian language and literature professors at Indian universities in Calcutta in November.

A seminar will be held on compilation of the Persian language dictionary and an exhibition would be set up to show the Persian language and literature books and softwares in Calcutta University soon, he added.

Under agreements reached with India, added Masjid Jamei, Iran's Culture and Islamic Guidance Ministry is to organize a seminar in commemoration of 'Ghalib Dehlavi' the Persian speaking poet of India.

He said that Indian officials are ready to send works of Indian Persian speaking poets written in superb calligraphic styles, to be put on show at a fair in Tehran.

Formation of the Persian language and literature association in India and establishment of Dar-ul-Quran (house of the Holy Quran) at an Iranian mosque in Bombay were among achievements of Iranian delegation's visit to India, he added.

There are 62 Persian language courses at Indian universities, which are to be strengthened by Iranian Culture and Islamic Guidance Ministry, said Masjid Jamei, adding that Iran is to support publication of the Persian books by Indian universities' Persian language and literature instructors.
