



Iran, Greece to review promotion of agricultural cooperation

TEHRAN - The new Agriculture Minister of Greece, George Anomeritis, will visit Tehran next week for talks with Iranian officials to promote agricultural cooperation between Greece and the Islamic Republic.

Iran's Ambassador to Athens, Mehdi Khandaq-Abadi, Tuesday met Anomeritis and handed him a congratulatory message and an invitation by Iran's agriculture minister to visit Tehran, IRNA reported from Athens.

Anomeritis was appointed to his new post in a mini-reshuffle of the Greek cabinet last Thursday.

Khandaq-Abadi and anomeritis discussed the prospects of cooperation in the field of agriculture between the two countries and reviewed the progress of bilateral ties, an Iranian embassy source said.

Islamic Revolution successful in awakening many nations

TEHRAN - The Leader of the Islamic Revolution Ayatollah Ali Khamenei here Tuesday received thousands of the university and school students on the occasion of birth anniversary of Imam Ali (a.s.), the first Imam of the Household of Prophet Mohammad (peace be upon him) and on the eve of Student Day (November 4).

The Leader in his speech said that arrogant powers are against the Iranian nation, Islamic Revolution and the sovereign state of the Islamic Republic of Iran due to its influence over other nations on the preservation of their identity, alertness and resistance to the arrogant satanic designs, IRNA reported.

Referring to the prevailing problems in the communities of mankind and the domineering policies of the world of arrogance, Ay-

atollah Khamenei stated, "lack of insight and patience has caused many nations to fall under the domination of the colonial powers."

"In the pre-revolution period, Iran faced similar maligns which led to British, Russian and then the U.S. dominions over the destiny of the Iranian nation for many years," the Leader said.

The Leader of the Islamic Revolution then added that when some learned and intellectuals and a great personality like the late Imam Khomeini appeared in the political scene of Iran, they inspired the Iranian nation by imparting them with the lesson of attaining insight and the show of resistance."

"It was through such historical lessons that the Iranian nation was able to create a new horizon in the history of Iran and decisively end the foreign domination

over the country," Ayatollah Khamenei stated.

Calling on nations to preserve their alertness and resilience, the Leader said that the arrogant powers and those at the head of economic companies and cancerous propagandas machines have been spending billions dollars on fighting the alertness and resistance of the nations in order to pave the way for continuation of their domination over other nations.

Ayatollah Khamenei specified that the Islamic Revolution of Iran was successful in clearing off 'the clouds of disappointment' by awakening many nations and that a large number of the youths in different countries have become the followers of the true ideology of Islam.

The Leader of the Islamic Revolution added that Islam is against domination of any power over the Muslim nations and calls on nations to resist any domineering policy. That is why the arrogant sates danger of the Islamic alertness and resistance, the Leader said.

Referring to the Student Day (November 4) and the fall of the U.S. espionage den in the hands of the students following the triumph of the Islamic Revolution, the Leader said that the taking over of the U.S. espionage den in Tehran was a reaction by the students to U.S. plots and satanic

measures against the Islamic Revolution and the interests of the Iranian nation.

The Leader then referred to the U.S. conspiracies and hostilities against the Iranian nation even after the triumph of the Islamic Revolution and stated that Washington was trying through its various plots to defeat the revolution and the sovereign state of the Islamic Republic of Iran with an aim to bring back the ousted Pahlavi regime within a short time, but the Americans did not understand Islam, revolution, nation and the Iranian officials and even today they are not able to understand the Iranians.

"Outwardly the tone of the U.S. officials has become gentle, but inwardly they are the same and trying to once again spread their political and economic domination over the resources of the country and that they do not want to see the sovereign state of the Islamic Republic of Iran which is against continuation of their illegitimate domination," the Leader added.

The Leader then described the claim that said having no relations with the U.S. would not be in the interest of Iran as an old weapon and noted that "having no relations with the U.S. is one hundred percent in the interest of the Iranian nation and that the available experiences around the world have proved this reality."

TEHRAN - Turkish President Suleyman Demirel Tuesday praised Iran's role and efforts, those of President Mohammad Khatami as the chairman of the Organization of the Islamic Conference (OIC) in particular, in defusing the recent tension between Ankara and Damascus.

Demirel made the remark in a meeting with the visiting Iranian Minister of Finance and Economic Affairs Hussein Namazi and other finance ministers attending the 2-day meeting of the Standing Committee for Economic and Commercial Cooperation (COMCEC) of OIC which commenced in Istanbul on Tuesday, IRNA reported from Ankara.

The Turkish president also termed as fruitful visit to Turkey and Syria of Iran's Foreign Minister Kamal Kharrazi.

Meanwhile, Namazi and Saudi Arabian state minister for economic affairs stressed promotion of Tehran-Riyadh ties.

In a meeting on the sideline of the COMCEC meet, the Saudi minister expressed satisfaction with the growing trend of Tehran-Riyadh relations. Stressing that no foreign factor can mar friendly ties between the two countries, he voiced Saudi Arabia's readiness to expand trade and economic cooperation with Iran. He also lauded Iran's active participation in a recent exhibition in Saudi Arabia.

Iran calls for collective participation in peace-keeping operations

TEHRAN - A member of the Iranian mission to the United Nations in New York Tuesday said the Islamic Republic of Iran believes that the U.N. peace-keeping operations should be a manifestation of collective efforts by all members of the international community.

Mehdi Yusefi, speaking at the Tuesday session of the 4th committee of the U.N. General Assembly which focuses on political topics, said that such operations should give equal opportunities to all members for collective participation in all aspects.

The comprehensive review of the issue of peace-keeping operations in all aspects was the topic of Tuesday debates, IRNA reported from New York.

Poiting to the U.N. peace-keeping efforts over the past five decades, Yusefi said that valuable experiences of the past lend further proof to the fact that impartiality of peace-

keeping forces, satisfaction of belligerent parties and non-interference in internal affairs of the warring sides, are of prime importance in every single peace-keeping operation.

To this end, he added, peace-keeping operations should be conducted with transparent objectives and command structure in order to prove effective in the peaceful settlement of disputes. The Iranian envoy

said that while the Islamic Republic respects U.N. selection procedure in picking up countries for peace-keeping operations as well as the type of operation for each state, proposals which are offered by members should be studied without any prejudice.

The Islamic Republic of Iran has repeatedly announced readiness for taking part in peace-keeping operations, said Yusefi, adding

that however, the U.N. Security Council members with veto power are only authorized to select the participating countries.

In conclusion, Yusefi welcomed the U.N. proposal for dispatching a mine-detecting team to Iran and said the Islamic Republic has already taken steps in clearing mine fields and has signed a number of agreements with U.N. related organizations in this respect.

Kuwait, South Korea to cooperate with Iran on environment

TEHRAN - The Iranian Vice President and head of Environmental Protection Organization, Masoume Ebtekar on her arrival told IRNA here Tuesday that "groundswells have been paved on the environmental cooperation with both Kuwait and South Korea."

Ebtakar also said, "the Regional Organization for the Protection of Marine Environment (ROPME) has also agreed to set up a info networks on the geographical issues and centers for marine research in the member countries."

During her stay in Kuwait, she inspected one of the biggest research institutes in that country.

"Kuwait is ready to cooperate with the Islamic Republic of Iran on creating a network on water and air pollution," said the vice president.

EPO head further said, "leaders of the ROPME member countries have been motivated to pump in investments on the environmental projects."

At the meeting with the Kuwaiti emir, lauding Kuwait women's participation in the matters related to academic issues, Ebtakar stressed women participation in political scene at this exchange of talks.

The Iranian vice president also stated that she had talks with the South Korean president, foreign minister, minister of health

and environment on the sideline of the regional conference on the development of Asia and Oceania in the third millennium'.

At the meeting with the Korean minister of health and environment, the two sides had agreed to cooperate to carry research on the effects of pollution on the urban dwellers of the two metropolitans, Seoul and Tehran.

Both South Korea and Iran have agreed to step up cooperation in the transfer of Iranian experience and South Korean technology.

Iran's vice president said that at the meeting with South Korean President, Kim Dae Jung, he lauded President Khatami's logical policies in promoting open political atmosphere, stimulating economic growth and cultural rapprochement. Kim also expressed his interest in Islam, Iran and values upheld by Iranian nation.

Students stage rallies to mark November 4

TEHRAN - Rallies to mark November 4—the national day of campaign against world arrogance and the student day staged throughout the country on Wednesday.

The day marks three important events in the history of the country; sending to exile the late Founder of the Islamic Republic, Imam Khomeini, the student day and seizure of the former U.S. embassy in Tehran by the students following the line of the Imam. Following the takeover the embassy came to be known as the den of espionage.

The rally, which commenced with recitations from the Holy Quran, last until noon when the students converged before the embassy compound to demonstrate their unity and express their strong hatred towards the world arrogance and its policies.

Secretary of the Expediency Council Mohsen Rezaei addressed the rally.

University and high school students participating in rallies expressed their strong opposition to the U.S. hegemonic policies.

They also renewed their allegiance to the Leader's view on relations with the U.S. to the effect that ties with U.S. are contrary to Iranian nation's interests and there will be no relation as long as Washington continues to plot against Iran.

Iranian embassy in Sweden offers sympathy to fire victims

TEHRAN - The embassy of the Islamic Republic of Iran in Stockholm, Sweden, in a statement Tuesday expressed deep concern over the deadly arson at a cultural center in the city of Gothenburg in which scores of young people, including some Iranians, were killed, IRNA reported.

The statement offered sympathy to the bereaved families and close friends of all those who were either killed or injured in the tragic incident.

The fire at the overcrowded Halloween party in the city of Gothenburg, which claimed lives of 62 youths of 13 to 18 years of age, has been turned into a national catastrophe and a banner headline in print media. Following the incident, a day of national mourning was announced in Sweden and flags were flown on half mast out of respect for the victims.

The Swedish press reported that in addition to the

62 victims, out of whom 37 including 6 Iranians have so far been identified, 160 others were also hospitalized due to their wounds.

Two-thirds of the victims were migrants with different nationalities who

took part in a teenage party held at the premises of the Macedonian cultural center.

The venue of the tragic incident where up to 400 youths had gathered was licensed to take only 150, reports said.

Outlines of law on Iran's membership in Intl. organizations approved

TEHRAN - The Islamic Consultative Assembly (Majlis) has approved the outlines of the bill on Iran's membership in international organizations and fora. The bill obliges the government to revitalize the Iranian Organization of International Communities and the approval of its new charter.

It said that the organization is required to study, evaluate and give its specialized opinion on Iran's membership in the international organizations.

UNHCHR chief to visit Iran

TEHRAN - The U.N. High Commissioner for Human Rights (UNHCHR), Mary Robinson, is to pay her second visit to Iran early next year. British Foreign Office Minister Baroness Symons has revealed.

Issues being covered include Russia's monopoly of northern pipelines, inter-country conflicts in Azerbaijan, Armenia, Georgia, Chechnya, Turkmenistan and Kazakhstan, and U.S. sanctions threats against export routes via and through Iran.
