Parliament approves manufacture of national satellite

TEHRAN - The Islamic Consultative Assembly (Majlis) has approved allocation of Dls 50-300 million for manufacture of Iran's national satellite. Speaking to reporters, deputy at Post, Telegraph and Telephone Ministry in educational, research and technology affairs, Mostafa Safavi said that specific points has been determined on the geo stationary orbit (GSO) for Iran. In case of Iran's failure to use these points they will be turned over to other applicable countries, he said.

Safavi added as Iran lacks such a technology it will assign manufacture of the national satellite to a foreign company through an international tender.

Chairman of Expediency Council:

Afghan ethnic groups must end fighting, establish peace

TEHRAN - Chairman of the Expediency Council of the Islamic Republic of Iran Akbar Hashemi Rafsanjani said on Tuesday the Shi'ite and Sunni religious leaders and the tribal leaders in Afghanistan should reach an understanding to put an end to fighting and destruction in the country.

In a meeting with the members of the secretariat of the Afghan Shi'ite and Sunni religious leaders, Rafsanjani expressed regret over the miserable situation in Afghanistan and said unfortunately, the events in the wake of driving the (former Soviet) occupation force from Afghanistan, civil war

and fratricide turned the sweetness of the victory into a bitter tragedy and the extent of bloodshed is growing day by day, IRNA reported.

Rafsanjani said use of force and violence will get nowhere in Afghanistan.

Rafsanjani said, "now after years of civil war and fratricide in Afghanistan it has become clear to all factions and ethno-religious entities that fighting and violence will not bring victory and there is no other alternative but participation of all factions to establish peace and security."

He said unilateral support for a specific group in Afghanistan is also futile

and now some neighboring states have reached the conclusion that backing an Afghan group and ignoring the others will not solve any problem, but on the contrary will aggravate the situation.

Rafsanjani said the current situation in Afghanistan is harmful to the neighboring states, the region and the entire world.

"Exporting drugs from Afghanistan has embarrassed the world. The neighboring states are required to prepare the ground for national reconciliation in Afghanistan and a broad-based government to be formed in the country," he said.

President:

Defense of constitution essential for safeguarding values

TEHRAN - President Mohammad Khatami here Tuesday said that defense of the constitution is a must for preservation of Islamic and revolutionary values.

The president made the remark in a meeting with members of the board for following up and supervision over the performance of the constitution.

Praising the efforts made by members of the board in fulfilling their responsibilities with an academic and realistic outlook, the president said that the constitution is the pivot of the Islamic system.

Underlining the need for clarification of the status of the president in connection with his responsibility in enforcing the constitution, Khatami said the limit of the authority that has been bestowed to the president to defend people's rights should be specified.

Calling on members of the board to further practice scrutiny in their work, the president said that parts of the problems facing the constitution originate from ambiguities existing in the law.

He told the board members to continue their effort and remove the present ambiguities on the basis of academic methods as was practiced before.

Iran, Pakistan to coordinate anti-drug campaign with UNDCP

TEHRAN - Secretary of Iranian anti-drug campaign headquarters Mohammad Fallah, his Pakistani counterpart Tariq Aziz and head of the United Nations Drug Control Program Bernard Farragi opened a two-day meeting in Tehran to coordinate anti-drug campaign.

Addressing the tripartite meeting, Fallah said the drugs have caused great problem requiring an international cooperation among states and the United Nations Drug Control Program, IRNA reported.

He said the drug trafficking brings a large quantity of profit and the traffickers become increasingly richer.

He said after the Iranian military exercises in the eastern borders of the country, the traffickers have now moved to the Iran-Pakistan borders. He called for an intensified action by the two countries drug fighting squads.

The Pakistani official in charge of campaign against drug trafficking said Pakistan is ready to make use of the experiences of the Islamic Republic of Iran in fighting drugs.

He said the Pakistani

government has adopted strategy to prevent poppy cultivation and to replace planting poppy with other products.

Aziz said in 1980s, about 80,000 hectares of land were under cultivation of poppy seeds which it has now declined to only 2,000 hectares. He expressed hope that in the year 2000 the figure would fall to zero. The Pakistani official said the problem of drug smuggling to Iran and Pakistan will not be solved unless a stable government comes to power in Iran.

Aziz said about 4.3 million drug addicts are living in Pakistan and the Pakistani government is working hard to stop smuggling of drugs to save the young generation in Pakistan.

Farragi said this part of the world especially Afghanistan is the center of international concern.

He said in 1998, 63,000 hectares of land went under poppy cultivation in Afghanistan, yielding 2,100 tons of drugs.

The UNDCP official said wide-scale cooperation between the Iranian and Pakistani police forces are required to fight transit of drugs in the border areas.

'Green' festival to screen over 450 films

TEHRAN - Over some 450 Iranian and Foreign movies are to be screened at the International Sabz (green) Film Festival in Tehran, secretariat of the festival announced on Tuesday.

The six-day film festival is to start from February 28 up to March 5 in which 23 animation films, 318 documentary and feature movies, 14 video clips along with 12 feature movies are to be shown for the public, IRNA reported.

According to the report, the number of movies which have been sent to the festival has set a record compared to similar festivals held around the globe.

The films from Iran, France, Sweden, the Netherlands, China, Japan, Switzerland, America, Greece, Britain, Kyrgyzstan, Russia, Germany, Australia, Canada, India, Korea, Turkmenistan, Hong Kong, Lebanon and Tajikistan are to be screened during the festival.

In addition to the above movies some 25 other movies produced by the UNESCO and Iran are to be shown in English.

Iranian airlines to use nursing services

TEHRAN - The first group of flight nurses will start their work in Iranian airlines on their local and foreign flights simultaneous with the 20th anniversary of the victory of the Islamic Revolution, it was announced here Tuesday.

Speaking to IRNA, official in charge of the recently-held flight nursing course, Dr Jamshid Sharafi, said the aim behind such a course is to increase clinical care for passengers and boost flight safety and prevent possible mortality.

According to Sharafi in many parts of the world employment of flight nurses in long distance flights, emer-

gency landings in war time or in unprecedent events has served to lower flight mortality rate and thus, increasing flight safety.

He said that the course is co-sponsored by Iran's Civil Aviation Organization, Assemay airline, Iran Air and the Air Force. Holding the course has saved the country Drs 1.2 million, he said adding that the course was held according to all international standards.

Iran can hold such courses in other developing countries especially in Islamic countries, he added.

Graduation ceremony of the students will be held on February 18.

Islamic Labor Party comes into existence

TEHRAN - Islamic Labor Party started its work officially with Alireza Mahjoub, Ms. Soheila Jelodarzadeh and Abdor-Rahman Tajeddin as its founding members.

Abolqasem Sarhadzadeh, an active member of the party, told IRNA Tuesday that the party aims to make production forces contribute to political power.

Despite having their own representatives in the Islamic Consultative Assembly (Majlis) the production forces are not present in the decision making centers, he said adding "we are of the belief that the absence of production forces in political centers has caused several economic problems thus, causing diversion of economic projects."

In its latest congress in last May the Worker House decided to establish the Islamic Labor Party.

TEHRAN - The Bahraini Foreign Minister, Sheikh Muhammad bin Mubarak bin Hamad al-Khalifa said in Manama on Tuesday, "we are optimistic about prospect of ties with Iran as well as

'Children of Heaven' nominated for Oscar award

TEHRAN - The Iranian film 'Children of Heaven', directed by Majid Majidi, is a 1999 Oscar nominee in the best foreign film category.

The film depicts the story of a sister and brother from a poor family but with great human expectations who live with their parents in a shanty home in Tehran.

The daughter of the family, the 7-year old Zahra, loses her shoes on her way home from a cobbler together with her 9-year old brother Ali. The two decide to conceal the secret from their parents and as a solution plan to use Ali's canvas shoes alternately.

In an article appearing in the weekly Gazette, the American film critic, Diana Green has described 'Children of Heaven' as unparalleled in its kind.

Green has opined that Iranian films, compared to the world's most famous films, are the essence of simplicity, attraction and meaningfulness.

She said such films begin with a simple story but gradually develops into a great human drama.

'Children of Heaven' will be screened in Washington on Friday.

Iran Khodrow' sets new record in auto production

TEHRAN - Managing Director of Iran Khodrow company Manouchehr Gharavi said that his company has produced 111,112 vehicles, including taxis, vans, 96,828 Paykan and 14,284 Peugeot cars since March 21, 1998. Talking to reporters, Gharavi said the number of vehicles produced by the company equalled last year's total output.

Gharavi said that his company sold over 107,000 vehicles to applicants in the said period.

He said that Iran Khodrow is expected to produce as many as 250,000 Paykan and Peugeot cars by March 20, 2000.

Moreover, he said that 1,776 buses have been produced by the company since March 21, 1998.

He added that 400,000

people are engaged in production of auto spare parts of whom 80 to 90 percent offer their products to Iran Khodrow.

70 percent of Peugeot parts are manufactured domestically and there are plans to manufacture all other parts inside the country by March 20, 2000, Gharavi noted.

Iran Khodrow exported Drs 15 million worth of

Peugeot parts produced at the company this year and the export figure is expected to reach Drs 28 million next year, he said, adding that his company has exported 500 Paykan cars to Sudan this year.

He said the country needs 500,000 vehicles annually and that annually more than 300,000 people apply for buying Iranian-made cars.

He did not give any numbers.

Turning to Islamic laws on amnesty, he said of course pardoning prisoners should not discredit judicial verdicts.

He expressed hope that more prisoners would be given leave to spend the new year holidays (beginning March 21) with their families this year.

Tehran to host APO session

TEHRAN - The 39th session of heads of productivity organizations of member states of the Asian Productivity Organization (APO) is to be held here next week.

The Organization for Employment and State Administrative Affairs in a statement issued here Monday, said that short-term and long-term programs of productivity organizations of the member states as well as programs implemented by the APO last year will be on the agenda of the meeting.

The Islamic Republic of Iran, Taiwan, India, Japan, South Korea, Nepal, Pakistan, the Philippines, Thailand, Vietnam, Sri Lanka, Indonesia, Singapore, Bangladesh, Malaysia, Fiji and Mongolia are member countries of the APO.

Iran, Chile to bolster bilateral relations

TEHRAN - The visiting Chilean Minister of Mining Sergi Jimenes Moraga in a meeting here Tuesday with the Iranian Foreign Minister, Kamal Kharrazi, submitted a message from Chile's President Eduardo Frei Ruiz-Tagle for his Iranian counterpart President Mohammad Khatami.

In the meeting, Moraga and Kharrazi exchanged views on ways to further bolster the two countries' bilateral relations, IRNA reported.

Moraga said that his country is ready to pave the way for the Islamic Republic of Iran to enter into the 800 million-populated market of the American continent.

Referring to the Chilean experience in area of the copper industry and the Iranian experience in the oil industry, Moraga expressed hope that his visit to Iran will help promote trade exchange between Tehran and Santiago specifically in these two sectors.

He pointed that the objective of appointing the Chilean accredited ambassador to Iran is to further promote the Iran-Chile bilateral relations.

Kharrazi on his part welcomed the Chilean minister currently in the Islamic Republic of Iran on an official visit so far has conferred with some of the ranking Iranian officials on the bilateral relations and cooperation specifically in economic areas.

Middle East and Central Asian region are two important nations which can exchange their experiences in various areas particularly in the copper and oil industries.

The Iranian foreign minister added that Chile can also use vast possibilities available in Iran such as the Iranian roads and railway to provide its access to Central Asian market.

The Chilean minister currently in the Islamic Republic of Iran on an official visit so far has conferred with some of the ranking Iranian officials on the bilateral relations and cooperation specifically in economic areas.

Japanese researcher:

Iranian women progressed well

TEHRAN - Iranian women's participation in the society is visibly increasing after the revolution, and "particularly after Khatami's presidency. The Iranian women have occupied high government and executive posts," said Hisae Nakanishi, political researcher on Middle East affairs and associate professor at Koryo international college in Japan.

Nakanishi told Iran News that during her stay in Iran she observed that Iranian women also work hard outside their homes and are really participating in public affairs.

Touching on the new image of Iran in the international arena after President Mohammad Khatami's victory, she said "after Khatami's victory in the presidential elections both western and Japanese media give full coverage to Iranian young women's participation in politics."

She said that she had witnessed for herself that more women including younger ones are participating in many governmental positions and working in female societies and unions."

Nakanishi also noted that political consciousness

of women in Iran is higher when compared to Japanese women adding "I can find some similarities between Iran and Japan about divorce law. I believe that women's rights in the family should be more improved in both countries."

On the recent visit of Iranian foreign minister to Japan, she expressed hope that friendly relations between Iran and Japan will improve.

Ms. Nakanishi was here on the invitation of the Ministry of Culture and Islamic Guidance to participate in a seminar on the basics of dialog among civilizations.

Foreign minister: Iran, world's most independent, stable country

TEHRAN - Foreign Minister Kamal Kharrazi here Monday said that the Islamic Republic of Iran is the most independent and stable country in the world.

Addressing officials and staff of the Foreign Ministry, he stressed that Iran can be a good model for other countries, IRNA reported.

Praising his ministry's role in cultural and economic affairs abroad, he said that in foreign policy affairs, the ministry is responsible for both policy making and carrying out policies. Kharrazi further underlined the need for making use of knowledge of the Iranian thinkers in order to improve the country's foreign policy.
