The editors of *Electronic Antiquity* are pleased to announce that with this issue, the journal will move from an html web format to a PDF format. This change will provide several advantages: 1) the journal will have a physical appearance more like a paper journal; 2) articles can now be cited by page numbers in bibliographical references; 3) we will easily be able to present ancient Greek without transliteration; 4) those who print out articles will have a much better format to read; 5) there will be more security for the authors since we will now make the PDF files readable and printable, but not alterable, by the public.
