Her supervisor, Rick Johnson, says, "The end result of Earlene's extraordinary efforts at training is a well trained unit support person, a support person who is more likely to be retained in their job, thus, lessening the chance of turnover; and a customer (student) who is better served because management can focus on their needs while Earlene trains staff behind the scenes."

Her attention to detail in addition to her methodical training ensured my full and complete understanding of this vital task. . . . Sometimes I wonder how she does it; but then I have the answer when I realize it's because she is who she is!"
- " "When I joined Student Programs in November 2003, there was no existing job description for the position I filled. Ms. Meredith was, and still is, a constant source of information and knowledge. She trained me over three months on leave reporting, providing me with a training manual that she personally prepared as a resource tool, which I still use. . . . She is gracious enough to assist me in a bind, and has never made me feel incompetent or irresponsible for needing her assistance. Because of this, I have the utmost respect and admiration for her."
